# Rose Festiva



MAY 14 (Sun) ~ June 4 (Sun)

Kusabue-no-Oka Rose Garden is home to around 2,500 rose plants of some 1,250 varieties mainly including the original species of roses, old and rare, which are precious in the world. The Rose Garden is divided into areas such as the Suzuki Seizo's (Mr. Rose) Corner, the Japanese and Chinese roses corners, the Santa Maria Valley area where you can enjoy many kinds of roses, etc.

In 2014, Kusabue-no-Oka Rose Garden was awarded the title of "Rose Garden Hall of Fame" by the Great Rosarians of the World's program in San Marino, USA. In 2015, it was also awarded the "Outstanding Garden Award" by the 17th World Rose Society. At Kusabue-no-Oka park, events such as concerts and various activities will be held during this period.



# PROCEDURES AFTER THE CHILD ALLOWANCE SYSTEM HAS BEEN TERMINATED

If your income in 2021 exceeded the maximum income limit and you have not received any child allowance since June 2022, and if your income during 2022 is below the maximum income limit, you will need to reapply for the child allowance. Please confirm the amount of your 2022 income by checking the tax notice issued in May or June. In order to receive the allowance for June 2023 (the payment month is October 2023) you must apply for the allowance within 15 days from the day on which you became aware of the fact that your income has fallen below the maximum income amount. If the application is filed after 15 days, the payment will be made on the following month after the application has been submitted. For details, please refer to the website.

# **FY 2023** LIGHT VEHICLE TAX



Municipal Tax Section (Shiminzei-ka) 2 484-6114

A light vehicle tax is levied for any light vehicle (including mopeds, small bikes, small-sized special vehicles, and three- and four-wheeled light vehicles) as of April 1 each year. The applicable tax rate differs depending on the vehicle type and the date of the First-Year Inspection (FYI).

## The deadline for light vehicle tax payment is May 31 (Wednesday).

Making your payments via a transference is convenient and reliable, just make sure to check the balance of your account before making the payment. Please pay by the due date at the nearest banking institution or convenience store.

## **2023** SCHOOL LUNCH SUBSIDY FOR THE THIRD AND SUBSEQUENT CHILDREN

In order to reduce the financial burden of raising children in households with multiple children, we will subsidize the amount equivalent to school lunch expenses during the compulsory education period for the third and subsequent children.

Guardians who meet all the following points will receive the subsidy:

- (1) Supporting 3 or more children.
- ② The third or later child of the dependent children in ① is receiving school lunch at a municipal elementary or junior high schools (including those who bring their own lunch due to allergies, etc.).
- ③ The household does not receive full subsidies for school lunch through the national, prefectural or city governments.
- ④ There are no tardy or unpaid school lunch fees in the household.

To apply, please bring or mail the application form to the school your child attends. \*Applications must be submitted by May 22 (Monday) to receive the subsidy from April. \*Please see the website

# PAYMENT OF INJURY AND SICKNESS ALLOWANCE ASSOCIATED WITH THE NEW CORONAVIRUS INFECTION.

Citizens enrolled in the Sakura City National Health Insurance or Medical Care System for the advanced elderly who are infected or suspected of being infected with the new coronavirus infection, who have taken time off from work for this reason and have not received a sufficient salary from the business owner, etc., injury and sickness allowance can be paid when you are unable to receive such benefits.

**Targets:** Those persons who meet all four of the next conditions:

- 1) Those who are enrolled in the Sakura City National Health Insurance or Medical Care System for the elderly aged 75 years old or over and who are receiving salaries, etc. from business operators.
- ② Being unable to work due to medical treatment or because are infected with the new coronavirus spread disease, or having symptoms such as fever and being suspected of contracting the virus by May 7, 2023.
- ③ Have been absent from work for 3 consecutive days and there are days off from the fourth day onwards.
- 4 Unable to receive payment of salary or being paid with a partial reduction of it.

Not eligible if the person does not have symptoms such as fever, refrains from going to work as a close contact person or if he/she is ordered to stay at home by the employer.

Applicable period: Period during which you are unable to work due to medical treatment (except the first 3 days). 

\*The period limit during which you can apply from the time you are unable to work is 2 years.

Payment amount calculation: Total amount of salary income for 3 consecutive months **÷** number of working days **x** 2/3 **x** number of days. There is an upper limit to the amount of payment.

How to apply: The application must be submitted by a doctor (If you visited a medical institution) and proof by the employer is required. Application forms are being distributed at the Health Insurance Section or can be downloaded from the city website. If you wish to receive the Injury and Sickness Allowance, please contact us in advance.
