Tokutei Kenshin (Specific Health Checkups) & Cancer Screenings (Part 1)

Kenkō Suishin-ka (Health Promotion Section) 22485-6711

Please note that the current scheduled screenings may be canceled depending on the status of the coronavirus infectious disease as well as the weather conditions.

- The following target people have started receiving Health checkup slips in late May:
- Residents covered by National Health Insurance (NHI) who are aged 40 years old and over.
- Residents aged 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65 or 70 years as of March 31, 2024.
- Male and female residents aged 19, 25 or 30 years or females aged 20 or 35 years as of March 31, 2024.
- Residents who took city's health checkups in FY
- Residents eligible for the vouchers for cancer screening offered by the Japanese Government.

For those who had the group screening for colon cancer in 2022 there will be enclosed a specific container in your checkup slip for this examination.

<<< IMPORTANT>>>>

To obtain your medical examination, please make sure to bring the following items: •your health checkup slip, •medical interview sheet, •health insurance card, •checkup fees, decision notification (group only, not required for colon cancer inspection).

- ◆ At the time of the medical examination day, Sakura citizens are eligible targets.
- ◆ Those who are 70 years or older and those covered by Latter-Stage Elderly Health Care system in Sakura City can apply for all the tests for both, collective or individual and it's free of charge.
- ◆ For households exempt from municipal tax, welfare recipients who have applied for a fee waiver at least three weeks in advance to the Health Promotion Section, the examination fee will be free of charge.

If the consultation ticket does not reach you at the beginning of June and you want to apply for this checkup, please contact the Health Promotion Section.

- ◆Reservations are required for group screenings. (Colon cancer screenings do not require reservation).
- ▶ Group screenings will be divided into the following two groups, both having different schedules. (Please refer to the Kōhō Sakura, June 1st issue for details on schedules and venues). Specific Medical examination (Tokutei Kenshin), Chest X-ray, Hepatitis, Colon Cancer screenings. GROUP 1:

Stomach cancer, colon cancer screenings.

- As for the colon cancer screening, you can receive medical examinations on either both the 1st or 2nd group dates.
- ► In order to avoid congestion and to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus infection, please arrive at your appointed time.

<<< ABOUT THE NINGEN DOCK SUBSIDY

Target people are residents covered by National Health Insurance (NHI) who are aged at least 40 years old and those covered by Latter-Stage Elderly Health Care system, but please note that those who have undergone the specific medical examination cannot benefit from the Ningen Dock Subsidy. If you apply for both, the specific medical examination as well as the Ningen Dock Subsidy, you will be required to return the subsidy.

ADULT DENTAL CHECKUP FROM 19 YEARS OLD

If your mouth is healthy, you can eat, talk and live a fulfilling life. The most common causes of tooth loss are tooth decay and gum disease. Take care of your teeth and oral health by having regular checkups and preventive treatment at your regular clinic at least once a year. Dental examination for new adults (19 years old) will be conducted too.

Those who fall under any of the following items should be especially careful:

- ☐ Cold and hot foods give my teeth a piercing sensation.
- ☐ I have a sticky mouth when I wake up in the morning.
- □ I have bleeding or swollen gums.
- ☐ I'm worried about bad breath.
- ☐ Gaps have formed between teeth.
- ☐ I have loose teeth.

Check if there is any decline in your mouth condition:

- ☐ I have lost some teeth and my jaw is weak.
- ☐ I can eat only soft foods.
- ☐ I choke over / spill the food while eating.
- ☐ I have no appetite / I can eat only a little.
- ☐ My tongue is in poor condition, I cannot roll it.
- ☐ My mouth is dry and I'm concerned about bad

breath.

LET'S HAVE MEDICAL CHECKUPS FOR PREVENTION AND EARLY DETECTION OF LIFESTYLE-RELATED DISEASES

Diseases such as hypertension, type 2 diabetes and lipid abnormalities often cause no subjective symptoms and the disease may progress without being noticed. If left untreated, these diseases can cause arteriosclerosis which is the aging of blood vessels and lead to serious life-threatening diseases such as stroke and heart attack. To prevent and detect diseases at an early stage, please get medical examinations. After the checkups, we will support your health promotion through various classes and individual consultations. These are free of charge but reservations are required.

Health consultations and classes include:

- ▶ Individual consultations. Please check page 4 of the June 1st health special edition issued by the City (In Japanese).
- ► Food classroom to know and prevent metabolic syndrome.
- ► Sakura City Health Up exercise class (exercise habit building class).
- ► Sakura City Original Gymnastics trial session.
- Study session for diabetes prevention.
- ► Specific health guidance: Those who are eligible for the health advice meeting will be notified individually.
