Each year about 100,000 visitors come to see the tulips in full bloom. Enjoy the coming of spring with the natural beauty of Lake Inba and magnificent view of tulips that paint the field with many colors. The festival presents tulips for sale, traditional Dutch costumes to wear, the performances of the Dutch street organ, rent-a-cycles and the sales of local products.

The museum collects artworks with connections to Sakura and the Boso area and holds exhibitions of modern and contemporary Japanese art. It is also a place for local residents to display their own works of art.
