The above-mentioned items must either be collected by the store of purchase or a specialized handling company. Do NOT dispose of these items at the garbage collection site under any circumstances.

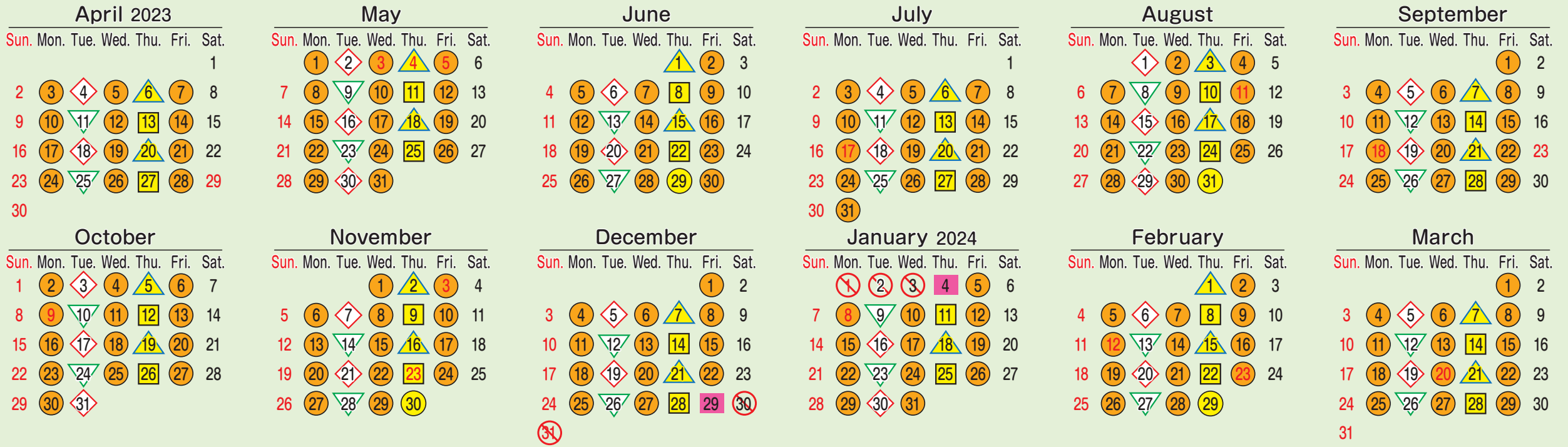
**<<Your cooperation is requested>>**

- Take out your waste to the collection point no later than 8:30 a.m. on collection day. Do not take out the garbage the day before or during the night before the pickup.
- Waste disposed of in bags other than those specified by the city will not be collected.
- For safety reasons, collection may be cancelled due to bad weather (such as typhoons or heavy snow).
- Business waste (general wastes from business activities / industrial wastes) is not collected by the city and must not be disposed of at collection points or collection stations.
- Do not use illegal trash haulers / junk pickup agents who have no permission from the city.
- Know before you throw! Follow the disposal rules and work together to keep our community clean!

◆ Pick-up request procedure

- Contact the above company to schedule a pick-up.**
  - Business hours: weekdays 8:30-17:00
  - Pickup hours: weekdays 8:30-17:00
  - No pick-ups on Sat., Sun., National Holidays, and Year End/New Year Holidays.
  - Inform your name, address, phone number, type of bulk waste, and preferred pick-up date.
- Purchase the Bulk Waste Disposal Ticket at a store.**
  - Check the fees in the item list below, then buy a disposal ticket for the correct amount from the stores indicated in the list on the right.
  - Tickets are non-refundable and cannot be reissued.
- Attach the ticket to the bulk waste and put it out.**
  - Write your name and date of collection on the ticket and attach it to the item where it is easy to see.
  - Set out on the designated site by 8:30 on the pick-up date.
  - Items without a disposal ticket attached will not be collected.
- Collected by a collection company**
  - No need to be present at the collection.
  - There will be no entry into the house for collection.
  - For housing complexes, place bulk waste at the garbage collection point on the premises or in an area that will not cause any nuisance on the property.

- Items that do not meet the conditions listed below (①) are not bulky waste, even if they appear on the "Bulk Waste Item Chart". Please put out for regular collection at a garbage collection point.

### [About the "Bulk Waste Item Chart"]

① Items that meet any of the conditions listed below are eligible.

SIZE	Items that do NOT fit in a 30-liter city-designated garbage bag (except for umbrella and cane made of metal).
WEIGHT	More than 5 kg per item

② "Small" size refers to items whose width, height, and depth are all less than 1.2 m in length. "Large" is defined as anything other than "Small".

③ The amount of the fee is for one item of bulky waste, unless otherwise specified in the table.

④ A combination of the items listed in the table below can be discharged for a fee of 500 yen if the quantity is up to five pieces and the weight is less than 15 kg.

Category	Items with (※1) mark in the <Bulk Waste Item Chart>: zabuton, futon, blanket, cushion.	Up to 5 pieces (sheets) in total (as for futon, up to 2 sheets)
Category 2	Items with (※2) mark in the <Bulk Waste Item Chart>: clothing storage box, trash bin, bucket, planter, tank (all made of plastic).	Up to a total of 5 pieces

(e.g.) For a combination of "Futon" and "Blanket" According to the item chart, the cost for up to three futons and five blankets is 500 yen each.  
 → If the total weight of two futons and three blankets is less than 15 kg, they can be disposed of with a single 500 yen coupon.  
 ※3 Set out your bicycle with the key in the lock.  
 ※4 Drain the fuel inside.

#### ● Counter Collection for smartphones, mobile phones, PHSs, tablets and smartwatches

While commercial collection service are preferred, we will collect them at the Garbage Control Section counter (5th floor of Sakura City Hall "building 1") to the extent that the city can process them.  
 Bring the device with an empty charge as it will be destroyed.  
 \*Be sure to delete all personal data before disposal.  
 \*Smart phones, mobile phones, PHSs, tablets, and smartwatches should NOT be disposed of in collection receptacles for small appliances.

PCs which are not needed at home should be disposed of in the either following way.
