SAKURA AUTUMN FESTIV



15:00-22:00, OCT.14(FRI), 15(SAT) & 16 (SUN) The Sakura Autumn Festival is the biggest cultural event of our city. Mikoshi (lavishly decorated portable shrines), and Dashi (traditional festival floats), some of which are cultural assets dating back to the *Edo* era (the samural period), are carried or pulled by residents clad in happi coats in a procession along the designated route of the old Sakura castle town.

THE 290TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE OH-MIKOSHI CONSTRUCTION

This year marks the 290th year since the construction of the Oh-Mikoshi of Makata-jinja, and the previous Mikoshi, which was handed over to Jyo Makata-jinja at the construction of new Mikoshi 290 years ago, is to visit its home shrine in celebration of the anniversary. It is the first time in history that these two Mikoshis compete with each other. On Saturday, all the Dashis will move to the event site of the festival and will make a procession one after another along the Shin-machi street. You just could not miss it!

Many vendors will be setting up stalls selling food and drinks, souvenirs and local merchandise, games and so forth to entertain and cater for a large crowd of spectators during the 3-day festivities. As usual, traffic jams are foreseen around the

festival site, so you are requested to refrain from visiting the festival by car, bicycle, or motorcycle. Roads leading to the festival site and the parade route will be closed to traffic during the 3 festive opening hours. CHANGES TO CHILD ALLOWANCE (KODOMO-TEATE)

As of October 1, 2011, details of the Child Allowance system have been changed. As a result, allowance can be paid to eligible guardians by applying **on or before March 31, 2012** for the period between October 2011 and March 2012. **Monthly Pay per Child is:** 15,000 yen for children aged under 3 years; 10,000 yen for children aged 3 and up to school age (15,000 yen for the third and subsequent children); 10,000 yen for junior high students. There is no income cap. Application forms and/or information leaflets are to be mailed to relevant persons late October. Bring the child you are registering with you when you apply for a kindergarten. During the application period, each kindergarten provides nursing services. Be sure to bring your *in-kan* (family seal) and *juh'min-hyoh* (certificate of residence) or

"*gaikokujin-tohroku-gempyoh kisai-jikoh shoh'meisho* (certificate of confirmation of foreign resident registration)" containing information on the relationships of all family members to the householder. These certificates are available at *Shimin-ka* (the Citizens Section), City Hall.

RADIATION TEST RESULTS

NEW RICE HARVESTED THIS YEAR

- •On August 31, Chiba prefecture announced the results of the new rice radiation tests. In Sakura City, **no** radiocesium was detected at all the test sites. In accordance with the prefecture-wide test results, Chiba prefecture issued a declaration of safety of rice in Chiba on September 1.
- •Since the safety of new rice was confirmed, the voluntary ban on the sale and shipment of rice has been lifted now. Please feel at ease with eating tasty new rice in Sakura.

INGREDIENTS USED FOR PREPARATION OF SCHOOL MEALS

Radiation tests were conducted for five kinds of vegetables from around the City used for preparation of school meals. The results of these tests were; **No** radiocesium was detected with Yamato-imo, Ha-negi (Green onion), Potato, and Sato-imo (Taro); and **4.5 Bq/kg** of radiocesium was detected with Pear. Since these results were far below 500 Bq/kg, the temporary legal limits for radiation in food and beverages in Japan set by the Food Sanitation Act, the above ingredients continue to be used in school meals. OPENINGS OF MUNICIPAL HOUSES

Two rooms at Ohja-jyutaku (apartment); Two rooms at Horinouchi-jyutaku; and One room at Fujisawa-jyutaku are currently available. Applications are to be accepted from Monday, October 3 to Friday, October 14. You are eligible to apply for them if: you live in Sakura for 1 year or more; you are not delinquent in payments of your city tax; and you have one or more relatives to live together*. There are additional requirements and qualifications to be a tenant, such as income limitation and co-signer. (*Those who are age 60 years or above can apply without a relative to live together.) The city of Sakura offers annual osteoporosis test for Sakura residents who are/will be 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, & 70 years of age between April 1, 2011 and March 31, 2012. The first 1,000 applicants will be accepted for the test for \$500. We are now accepting your applications.

<Dates & places of the test>: Oct. 27 (Thu) at *Shizu Community Center*; Nov. 25 (Fri) at *Nambu Hoken Center*; Nov. 26 (Sat) and Dec. 7 (Wed) at *Kenkoh Kanri Center*; and Dec. 5 (Mon) at *Seibu Hoken Center*.

<Booking is required>: You can fill out and submit an application form at either one of the following health centers: *Kenkoh Kanri Center*, Seibu Hoken Center, or Nambu Hoken Center. Or you can send a fax or postcard with necessary information

INFLUENZA VACCINATION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

Influenza vaccination is available for senior citizens from October 1 at medical institutions in Sakura City, and at associated institutions in Chiba prefecture. From April 1, 2011, H1N1 flu is no longer considered a new influenza but a seasonal flu by the Ministry of Health,

Labour and Welfare (MHLW). Therefore, the 2010 -2011 flu vaccine is against regular seasonal flu. **Eligible persons** 1) 65 years old or older, for whom the city sent vaccination slips by mail at the end of September. Recipients should fill out the slip and bring it to a designated medical institution. 2) 60-64 years old who possesses a First Degree Identification Booklet for the Physically Handicapped, due to heart, kidney, or respiratory diseases. Please call *Kenkoh Kanri Center* to receive thevaccination.

Scheduled period Saturday, October 1, 2011 to Saturday, December 31, 2011. It takes about two weeks after vaccination for antibodies to develop in the body and provide protection against influenza virus infection. We recommend that all the elderly people receive an annual vaccination before early December. **Vaccination sites** Vaccination cooperative medical institutions in the City and the Prefecture

Cost 1,000 yen. Free for citizens on welfare if application is made along with presentation of a Welfare Recipient Certificate. In this case, please apply for a Welfare Recipient Certificate to *Syakai-Fukushi-ka* (Social Welfare Section) in advance.

*The vaccination subsidy for households which are not required to pay city taxes is not available this year. Call *Kenkoh-Zoh'shin-ka* (the Health Promotion Section), **2**485-6711 for further information.

Public health nurse will help you to develop a healthier lifestyle. Application required.
- Telephone counseling with public health nurse or nutritionist is available at each center, 8:30-17:00, Monday Friday. Dental hygienist or speech therapist are also available at Kenkoh Kanri Center.
