< Elementary School Pupils - English Speech/Recitation Performance>

< Non-Japanese - Japanese Speech Performance>

Three- to five-minute speech in Japanese language by non-Japanese people who either live, work, or study in Sakura City. The number of participants limited to five.

Self-Support for Single-Parent Families*

Sakura City provides four kinds of self-support programs for single-parent families as shown below. Eligible non-Japanese child and rearer are those who have been staying in Japan for at least the period specified. In and after July 2013, eligibility is checked based on one's income in 2012. Those who have not claimed these benefits so far because of the income limitation are recommended to review their income status. Also, the eligibility for Higher Skills Training Benefits and Educational Training Benefits has been expanded to include single fathers who start one of the designated trainings after April 1, 2013. Please be sure not to miss your opportunities!

- 1. Child Rearing Allowance (with income limitation. Recipients of public pension are not eligible)
- 2. Sakura City Medical Expense Subsidy for single-parents families (with income limitation)
- 3. Benefits for Higher Skills Training (to obtain certificate for assistant nurse, nurse, care worker, childcare worker, physiotherapist, and occupational therapist. Recipients in the past are not eligible)
- 4. Educational Training Benefits for Single Parent (with income limitation. Recipients in the past are not eligible)

* "Single-parent families" are families in which children grow without one of the parents. When applying for 1, 3, and 4, an interview is required. Under programs 1 and 2, allowance/subsidy will be paid basically until the fiscal-year end of the year in which the child reaches 18 years of age. Under the programs 3, monthly allowance will be paid for up to two years. As for application forms, please consult Jido-Seisyoh'nen-ka of Sakura City Hall.

■Ticket for Site B: ¥900 per person (¥1,000 at the event site on the day). In site B, visitors have to secure one's own space after entry to the site. A *HoloSpex* or Holographic Glasses will be presented to the first 5,000 visitors with B ticket.

\sim TO ALL FOREIGN NATIONALS RESIDING IN SAKURA \sim Juki Card Issuance for Foreign Residents Starts on July 8, 2013 Shimin-ka (Registration & Certification Services Section), 23484-6121

Starting on July 8, 2013, the "JuKi Daicho Network System" (Basic Resident Registration Network System) will start operation for foreign residents. The System is to increase convenience for residents as well as make administration procedures more rational. After the operation starts, foreign residents can obtain a Juki Card at the City Hall and copies of *Juminhyo* (Certificate of Residence) outside the City.

Major changes are as follows:

Juminhyo Code (Resident Record Code) is assigned to foreign residents

In accordance with this start of operation, Japanese government will assign a Juminhyo Code (Resident Certification Code) also to foreign residents in addition to Japanese residents. The Code is an 11-digit number that is essential in performing nationwide identity verification through the "JuKi Daicho Network System."

Foreign residents who have registered as a resident of Sakura City as of July 5 will be notified their individual code by postal mail sent out on July 8 by the City Hall. The Code will be necessary in various national services, so please keep it safely.

Foreign residents are able to receive a Juki Card (Basic Resident Registration Card)

Juki Card holders are eligible to use the simplified procedure for moving in and out of the City. Furthermore, copies of Juminhyo (Certificate of Residence) can be obtained also in a municipality other 写真付き

than the City you reside.

The Card carries the following information:

•Name and appellation (nickname)* •Date of birth •Sex •Address *Appellation previously shown on Alien Registration Card is not shown on Zairyu (Resident) Card. Please note that Juki Card is the only card that proves your appellation.



Documents etc. necessary to receive a Juki Card

1. When applying for a Juki Card, please visit the City Hall in person and submit an application form. A blank application form can be downloaded at:

- 2. At least two of the official documents listed below (at least one of them must carry your photo).
- •Insurance card •Passport •Pension book •Driver's license $\bullet Residence \ Card$ (Zairyu Card) or Alien Registration Certificate
- 3. Your photo (when applying for a Juki Card with photo) A Juki Card can be made with or without a photo. For a card with a photo, please prepare a photo of yourself (headshot with a plane background and without a hat, taken within the past six months, 45mm by 35mm).
- 4. Fee (500 yen)

To prevent pests and rice diseases, pesticides will be sprayed over paddy fields in Sakura from approximately 4:00 am to 10:00 am on the following schedule: <Caution!>

* Date and time are subject to change in case of bad weather. In case there are any changes, we will let you know over loudspeakers, etc.

- 1. Refrain from entering or driving onto the districts on the date of the pest control.
- 2. Refrain from leaving food or drinking water outside in the subjected and nearby districts.
- 3. If covers for vehicles or crops are necessary, please contact the Association in advance.
- 4. Refrain from entering the paddies for about five days after the day pesticides were sprayed.

<In case there is any problem...>

Should you accidentally be exposed to or inhale the pesticide, immediately rinse it away by gargling and using soap. Should any symptoms such as nausea appear, please call: Shokubutsu-boh'eki Kyoh'kai, 2485-6188.
