## THE 53RD SAKURA CITIZENS' FIREWORKS SHOW

19:00-21:00. AUGUST 3 (Sat)

(In case of bad weather, to be postponed to August 4)

Come and enjoy a summer spectacle of sound and light in the beautiful setting of *Imba-Numa* Lake! This Fireworks Show will surely become one of your most cherished memories in Sakura.

Opening ceremony is to be held at 19:00 and fireworks starts at 19:20 (subject to change). The hand-tube fireworks (Tezutsu Hanabi) can be seen only here in Kanto area. You can also enjoy water fireworks


beautifully light up the lake surface and jumbo aerial shells whose diameter is more than 23-inch (*Ni-shaku-dama*).

**Traffic Restrictions** Roads leading to the fireworks site are closed to vehicles on the day of the event from 17:30 to 22:00. The cycling road which runs through the restricted zone will be closed to both pedestrians and vehicles from 9:00, Friday, August 2 through noon, Sunday, August 4. Please also note that the time of the traffic opening might be delayed.

●No parking is allowed at the venue. Please walk from the nearest stations (30 minutes from Keisei Usui Station, 40 minutes from Keisei Sakura Station, and 60 minutes from JR Sakura Station). # EMERGENCY WARNING SYSTEM TO BE LAUNCHED ON AUGUST 30, 2013 By the Japan Meteorological Agency (JMA)

On August 30, Emergency Warning System by JMA will be launched. Emergency Warnings are issued to alert people to the significant likelihood of catastrophes in association with natural phenomena of extraordinary magnitude. Residents should take all measures possible to protect themselves in the event that an Emergency Warning is issued.

#### What is an Emergency Warning?

In addition to various warnings concerning heavy rain, earthquakes, tsunami and storm surges, JMA starts issuing Emergency Warnings. The issuance of an Emergency Warning for an area indicates <u>a level of exceptional risk</u> of a magnitude observed only once every few decades.

#### How can we get an Emergency Warning?

Emergency Warnings will be informed through the community wireless broadcast and mail delivery service by the City as well as other wide variety of media including TV and radio. Please look out for relevant messages such as municipal evacuation advisories and orders, and take all steps necessary to protect life.

The 15th Jidai Matsuri is now being prepared as a part of celebrating Sakura's 400th anniversary since the foundation of Sakura Castle. Setting the Shin-machi street as the main venue of the festival, a virtual town of Edo period will be recreated on November 16. The main events include: theatrical sword fights and famous arrest scenes performed by professional actors on the



street, Japanese-traditional street performances including Saru-mawashi (Monkey show), and lots more. Street Soran (Soran Bushi Dancing on the street) is also performed on the station street of Keisei Sakura station.

English and other seven language versions are available on request. The handbook is used for recording pre- and post-natal checkups, as well as keeping track of the child's vaccinations.

By using the coupons issued as a separate volume of *Boshi Kenko Techo*, a part of the medical checkup fees for pregnant women (for 14 times during pregnancy) and infants (1 time at the age of 3-6 months and 1 at 9-11 months) are borne by public funds. 
