SAKURA-NO-AKI-MATSURI



Sakura Autumn Festival 15:00 to 22:00 October 11 to October 13

Sakura Autumn Festival is the biggest cultural event of our city. *Mikoshi* (lavishly decorated portable shrines) and *Dashi* (traditional festival floats), some of which are historical assets dating back to the *Edo* era, are carried or pulled by residents clad in happi coats in a procession along

the designated route of the

old Sakura castle town. Please check the following Dashi and Mikoshi schedule.

Fri., October 11: Oh-mikoshi (A great portable shrine) comes out from *Makata-Jinja Shrine* at about 15:00. Dashi (Parade Floats) held by each town will be carried around the old part of Sakura City, surrounded by the residents dancing.


Sat., October 12: All the *Dashi* move to the event site of the festival and will make a procession one after another along the *Shin-machi* street.

Sun., October 13: Dashi will be carried around the old part of Sakura City. Oh-mikoshi returns into Makata-Jinja Shrine at about 21:40. A lot of vendors will be setting up stalls selling food and drink, souvenirs and local merchandise, games and so forth to entertain and cater for a large crowd of spectators during the 3-day festivities. You just couldn't pass up the opportunity to enjoy this historic event!

(Note) As it happens every year, traffic jams are foreseen around the festival site, so you are requested to refrain from visiting the festival by car, bicycle, or motorcycle. Roads leading to the festival site and the parade route will be closed to cars during the three-day festive opening hours.

DISASTER PREPARATORY DRILL

Sunday, October 20 at Negoh Elementary School

During a large disaster such as an earthquake, life lines including gas, electricity, drinking water services might be interrupted and roads might be closed. Possible life-saving activities by disaster prevention organizations can be very limited due to responses to multiple and simultaneous fires. It will be very important that each and every one of us prepares on a regular basis and cooperates with each other when hit by a major disaster. A preparatory drill allows us to prepare against damage and minimize losses by life-saving and fire-fighting activities. The City of Sakura will conduct a post-disaster preparatory drill as shown below focusing on emergency relief/treatment activities, training for initial fire-fighting and soup kitchen, and learning on how to operate an evacuation center. We look forward to everyone's participation.

INFLUENZA VACCINATION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

Influenza vaccination for senior citizens is available at 1,000 yen from October 1 at medical institutions in Sakura City. To protect yourself during the peak flu season, an early shot is highly recommended because it takes about two weeks for antibodies to develop in your body.

Period October 1 to December 31, 2013 (with appointment)

Location Vaccination cooperative medical institutions in Sakura City (Please make sure you call *Kenkoh Kanri* Center in advance if you are going to get a shot at institutions out of the City.)

Eligible persons

- 1) Citizens who are 65 years of age or above. Vaccination slips were sent out to applicable persons in late September. Please fill in the slip and bring it to the medical institution.
- 2) Citizens who are 60-64 years of age and possess a "First Degree Identification Booklet for the Physically Handicapped" because of heart, kidney, or respiratory diseases. Please call Kenkoh Kanri Center to consult. Fee 1,000 yen. Free for citizens on welfare if Welfare Recipient Certificate is presented, which can be obtained in advance at Shakai-Fukushi-ka of the City Hall.




