

Kyuh-Hotta-Tei (Lord Hotta's former residence) and Buke-Yashiki (Old Samurai houses of Sakura) plan special openings of certain parts of their facilities which are not



ordinarily open to the public on November 3, Bunka-no-hi (the Culture Day). At Kyuh-Hotta-Tei, the gatekeeper's lodge, the study-room wing, and the 2nd floor of the living-room wing can be viewed in addition to regular exhibition. 

- 2. Pay entry fee at post offices using the designated payment slip filled out with necessary information.



## **Subsidy for Installation of Energy-Saving Equipment**

**Applications acceptance starts on November 19**

- · Fuel cell for home use (Ene-Farm, co-generation system at home)(Up to 100,000 yen, limited to 10 households)
- · Home energy management system (HEMS) ......(Up to 10,000 yen, limited to 5 households)
- · Home battery system for EV ......(Up to 50,000 yen, limited to 5 households)
  - \* Amount of subsidy is limited to the amount of actual cost.

#### Eligible Persons

- Those who are installing the equipment into a house where the person is living or going to live, and those who are going to buy a house to which the system is already installed
- · Those who had no delay in paying the previous year's city tax
- Those who can submit the performance report after the installation of the equipment or the delivery of the house. (The installation or the delivery must be completed before March19, 2014.)
- · Those who have lived in the address where the equipment is installed before the submission of the performance report, and registered as Sakura citizens

#### How to apply

Please apply in person by submitting required documents to Seikatsu Kankyo-ka (Environmental Sanitation Section), on the fifth floor in Sakura City Hall. Application forms are available at City Hall, each branch office and service center. You can also download them from the City's website.

Applications are accepted starting on November 19 until the capacity is reached, on a first come, first served basis. For further details, please contact the section in charge.

#### POPULATION OF SAKURA CITY

As of the end of September 2013, the Japanese population of Sakura was 175,465 (86,747 males and 88,718 females) in 72,681 households. Registered foreign residents accounted for 2,110. The combined population of Sakura City was 177,575.
