SHICHI-FUKUJIN STAMP RALLY



Shichi-fukujin, which literally means "Seven Gods of Good Fortune," are said to bring wealth, happiness, and long life. The shrines/temples of the seven gods invite visitors to a Stamp Rally from January 1 through January 13 and on the 10th day of

every month, from 10:00 to 16:00. The seven shrine/temples are: Jindai-ji, Soh'en-ji, Reinan-ji, Shoh'rin-ji, Myoh'ryu-ji, Makata-jinja, and Daishoh-in. Stamping sheets for vermilion seals



are available for \(\frac{4}\)400 each at any of the shrine/temples, Rekishi-seikatsu-shiryoh'kan (Center of history and folklore)*, or the Sakura City Kankoh Kyohkai (1-minute walk from the south exit of Keisei Sakura Station, closed January 1 to 3). \(\frac{4}{2}\)200 will be charged per vermilion seal to be stamped on the sheet (at Makata-jinja and Daishoh-in, \(\frac{4}{3}\)300 for two seals), or you can just purchase a fully stamped sheet for \(\frac{4}{2}\),000 at the Rekishi-seikatsu-shiryoh'kan.

CITY SUBSIDY FOR COMPOSTERS & WASTE REDUCTION MACHINES

Taikibutsu Taisaku-ka (Garbage Control Section), 484-6149

Let's be eco-friendly and protect the environment by using waste reduction equipment. Sakura City offers citizens a subsidy for the purchase of home composters and/or raw garbage reduction machines (drying or fermenting system). To be granted the subsidy when purchasing one, bring your ID (some document showing your name and address, such as driver's license) and *hanko* seal to one of the prescribed shops shown below, and fill in the form at the shop so that you can get a discount by the amount of the subsidy. Please note that no subsidy can be paid after purchase. Shown below are eligibility and subsidy amount for each equipment.

Eligibility and Amount of the Subsidy

Eligible Equipment	Amount of Subsidy
- Composter (C)	¥2,000 or one third of the purchase price ⁽¹⁾ , whichever is lower
- Fermenting reduction machine (F)	(Limited to two equipment for one household in one fiscal year)
- Electric food waste reduction machine (E)	¥10,000 or one fourth of the purchase price, whichever is lower (Limited to one equipment for one household in one fiscal year)

FY2014 PARKING PERMIT FOR BICYCLES & MOTORCYCLES

For convenience of commuters who use stations in Sakura, the City provides bicycle/motorcycle parking at each station. The parking lots are administered and managed by a designated administrator, Japan Society of Parking Engineering. Applications for regular use (continuous use of bicycle/motorcycle parking during the period from April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015) are being accepted at each parking lot. You can apply for regular use for up to one year, or park your bikes temporarily by paying as you go.

For regular-use application, please submit the following information:

Bicycle parking: Model of the bicycle, Name of the manufacturer, identification number, color, theft prevention registration number, and user's ID (something certify your name and address)

Motorcycle parking (up to 50cc or 125cc, depending on the facility): License plate number, Color, and user's ID.

- * The above fees for regular use are for 12 months. The actual amount for regular use may differ depending on the number of months of actual use. Also, in case of cancellation before March 31, 2015, the fees for the remaining months will be returned.
- ** For those who are not residents of Sakura, the fees for regular use are two times of the above, while there is no difference in fees for temporary use.

For temporary parking, please make a payment each time to the manager at the parking lot. Fees for one-time use are $\S100$ for a bicycle and $\S210$ for a motorcycle up to 125cc.

How to apply

Application forms and guidance leaflets are available at the booth in each parking lot. Please fill out and mail it to the address indicated on the leaflet, or bring it to the booth you intend to use during 6:30-10:30 & 16:00-20:00 on weekdays and 8:00-12:00 on Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays. Please note that some of the parking lots get full very quickly.

SUBSIDY FOR NINGEN DOCK (MEDICAL CHECKUP)

Kenkoh Hoken-ka, ☎484-1783 (Who is covered by National Health Insurance) ☎484-6136 (Elderly aged 75 or over)

Application deadline is Monday, March 31, 2014

"Ningen Dock" means a full physical examination ("Ningen" means human, and the word "Dock" came from dry dock for ships). For a "Ningen Dock" that include <u>all</u> the checkup items of the "City's Specified Medical Checkup" taken between April 1, 2013 and March 31, 2014 (FY2013), half of the cost can be covered with a ceiling of \(\frac{\text{\$\text{\$Y}\$}}{10,000}\) by the City. Those who are aged 20 or over and haven't taken "City's Specified Medical Checkup" in FY2013, and subscribe to **National Health Insurance** or **Medical Care System for Elderly Aged 75 or Over** are eligible to apply for this subsidy. If you are going to take a Ningen Dock within this fiscal year, please submit the application form to Kenkoh Hoken-ka at City Hall (by postal mail or bring-in in person) at least two weeks before the checkup date. Application forms for this subsidy can be obtained at Kenkoh Hoken-ka at City Hall. Please note that your application must arrive by Monday, March 31, 2014.

POPULATION OF SAKURA CITY

As of the end of November 2013, the Japanese population of Sakura was 175,447 (86,734 males and 88,713 females) in 72,849 households. Registered foreign residents accounted for 2,134. The combined population of Sakura City was 177,581.
