At Johshi Koh'en Park (Sakura Castle Park), irises in purple, pink, yellow, white and blue are in full bloom until mid-June. At the lower garden of the Park, you can enjoy the beautiful landscape covered with some 9,000 flowers of 50 species of irises in a natural setting. Next to the iris field, you can also enjoy hydrangeas and water lilies on the water surface of the pond. During Shohbu Matsuri, you can participate in "NODATE" or open-air tea ceremony and there will be a lot of stalls to sell local products and food. Public bus service is available from Keisei Sakura station and JR Sakura station (please get off at the "Rekishi Minzoku Hakubutukan" (National Museum of Japanese History) bus stop), and free parking lot is also available at Jiyuh Hiroba Square in the Park.

POPULATION OF SAKURA CITY

As of the end of April 2014, the Japanese population of Sakura was 175,483 (86,647 males and 88,836 females) in 73,413 households. Registered foreign residents accounted for 2,168. The combined population of Sakura City was 177,651.

Under Japanese child allowance system, for parents/guardians raising children, allowance is provided until the fiscal-year end (March 31) after the child turns 15. In early June, the City sends *Genkyo-Todoke* forms by postal mail to those who are currently receiving Child Allowance (*Jido Teate*). In order to continue receiving child allowance, please report your financial status, children's ages, your pension plan participation status, etc. **Amount of Allowance**

Allowance Payment Schedule

Child Allowance is paid three times a year as shown below.

Children up to 18 years of age are included in the count until March 31 after the child's 18th birthday. Children over 19 years of age are not included in the number of children.

How to receive Child Allowance

Please fill in the Genkyoh-Todoke form and submit it along with the following documents to *Jidoh-seishoh'nen-ka* (Children & Youth Section) in the City Hall by post or in person no later than June 30 (effective on the postmark date). If you fail to submit it, you will not be able to receive the allowance for June and after. Please make sure to meet the deadline! <u>Documents required to submit along with *Genkyo-Todoke* are:</u>

(1) (If you are a subscriber of employee's or mutual pension insurance) <u>A copy of health insurance certificate</u>
(2) (If you are not registered as a resident of Sakura City as of January 1, 2014)

A certificate of the annual income and amount of tax paid

on conditions.

If you became eligible by moving into the city or having a new child, make sure you apply to the City Hall as soon as possible.

- Notes: The allowance period only starts from the following month of your application, and will not be paid retroactively
 - · City branch offices and other public facilities do not accept the application.



To help the residents enjoy long and healthy life, Sakura city has sent out Medical Interview Sheets and Health Checkup Slips to the following persons in late May. Various health checkups and cancer screenings are available starting this month. Please do not miss this opportunity to get checked.

- Citizens aged at 20 and 30 (female only), 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 70 (both male and female) as of March 31, 2015
- Citizens who took the city's health checkup in FY2013
- Citizens under National Health Insurance (including his/her dependent) of aged at 40 and above as of April 1, 2014
- Citizens eligible for the vouchers for Cancer Screening by the Japanese government
- Citizens aged at 19 (both male and female), 21 (male only), and 31 (male only) as of March 31, 2015 (This group is eligible only for Adult Dental Checkup.)

* For those who took colorectal cancer screening in FY2013, a container for the mass screening is enclosed.

Please be sure to bring your Medical Interview Sheet, Health Checkup Slip (*Kenshin-Jushin-Ken*), health insurance certificate, and checkup fee*. *: Cash payment of checkup fee will be required at the venue.

Eligibility for Free Checkups

- ① Those who are aged 70 or above as of March 31, 2015
- ② Those who are covered by the medical insurance for Latter-Stage Elderly (Kohki-kohreisha) Healthcare System
- ③ Those who are on public assistance
- ④ Those who belong to households exempt from city taxes
- * Hepatitis virus screening is free for those who are 40, 45, 50, 55, and 60 as of March 31, 2015.

Please note:

- If you would like to take the city's checkup but joined the Sakura City National Health Insurance on and after April 2, 2014, or have not received the Health Checkup Slip yet, please contact us.
- If you took the city's medical checkup, you cannot get subsidy for Ningen Dock. For details of Ningen Dock, please call: **23**Kanri-han, 484-6604 or

- If you are under category ③ or ④ of the "Eligibility for Free Checkups" shown to the left, prior application is required to get a free checkup. Please call the health center where you are taking the checkup at least 2 weeks before your preferred checkup/screening date.
- There is no parking lot at the elementary schools and Seibu Hoken Center. Also at the
 other sites, parking is limited. Please use public transportation whenever possible.

Please refer to Japanese Koh'hoh Sakura for details On your Health Checkup Slip, recommended venue and date for a mass screening are shown. When you take a mass checkup, please choose the date indicated if possible to ease congestion. When you take checkup at an elementary school, gymnasium or the like, please be prepared to fight against the heat or cold. Please refer to the June 1st issue of Koh'hoh Sakura (official newsletter of the City printed in Japanese language) for detailed schedule of mass screenings. For individual examinations, the names of doctors and dentists are also listed there.

How to make reservations Reservation can be made by any of the following methods: (1) Visit Kenkoh Kanri Center, Seibu Hoken Center, or Nambu Hoken Center (Please fill out the application form there) (2) Send a postcard to Kenkoh-zoh'shin-ka \mp 285-0825, 2-27, Ebara-dai, Sakura-shi, with the following information: **1** name of the screening test you want to undergo, **2** your address, **3** name, **4** date of birth, **5** age, **6** telephone number. or (3) Send a fax to Kenkoh-zoh'shin-ka, at **485-6714** with the information above.

- * For breast cancer and osteoporosis screenings, please inform us of your first to third choices of the date and the choice between morning and afternoon.
- * Applications prior to the start date of acceptance are invalid.
