

List of Persons who Require Special Assistance during Evacuation

In order to provide more effective evacuation support and other assistance to the foreign residents, elderly, disabled, and other people with special needs, Sakura City is preparing two types of "List of Persons who Require Special Assistance during Evacuation" starting this fiscal year. "The

list for evacuation in the event of a disaster (List A)" is to be used only in the event of a disaster, whereas "The list for evacuation for ordinary times (List B)" is to be used for developing evacuation plans through visits and interviews with the registered persons and watching them over in the normal times. The information to be recorded on the lists includes: name, birth date, address, and phone number of the

registrant, and the reason for the need of special assistance. The lists shall consist of the persons with any of the conditions in Table (1) and (2) below.

- Persons in Table ① are to be:
- Registered on List A automatically
- Registered on List B upon request
- All such persons shall have been notified last year.
- Persons in Table ② can make requests to be registered on both List A and B. Such requests are being accepted since last November.

Shichifukujin, which literally means "Seven Gods of Good Fortune,"

are said to bring wealth, happiness, and long life. From 10:00 to 16:00 from January 1 through January 11 (in addition to the 10th day of every month), the shrines/temples of the seven gods invite visitors to a Stamp Rally to collect vermilion seals of all the seven gods. Stamping paper is available for 400 yen at the temples, the shrine, Kankoh Kyohkai, Tezukuri Kohboh Sakura (closed January 1 to 3), and Café Ichioka (closed January 6 to 9). 200 yen per stamping of vermilion seal on the paper (300 yen for two seals of Makata Jinja shrine and Daishoh'in,), or you can just purchase a fully stamped paper for 2,000 yen at Café Ichioka.
