# Rose Festival at Kusabue-no-Oka Rose Garden Until Sunday, June 5

In the Rose Garden at Kusabue-no-Oka Park, beautiful roses of 2,500 plantings in 1,050 varieties are now in full bloom. The Garden has been awarded "Award of Garden Excellence" by World Federation of Rose Societies (WFRS) in 2015 following "The Rose Garden Hall of Fame Award" in 2014 by the Huntington

Foundation for its continued efforts to collect, preserve and introduce precious roses over years. Among its collection, unique roses can be seen that cannot be found anywhere else. The best season is until mid-June.

At Sakura Castle Park, irises in purple, pink, yellow, white and blue are in full bloom until mid-June. At the lower garden of the Park, you can enjoy the beautiful landscape covered with some 9,000 plantings of about 50 species of irises in a natural setting. Next to the iris field, you can also enjoy hydrangeas and water lilies on the water surface of the pond. During Shohbu Matsuri, you can participate in "NODATE" or open-air tea ceremony and there will be stalls to sell local products and food. Public bus service is available from Keisei Sakura station and JR Sakura station (please get off at the bus stop "Rekishi Minzoku Hakubutukan (National Museum of Japanese History)." Free parking lot is available at the Park.

Under Japanese child allowance system, financial support is available to households raising a child until the first March 31st after the child's 15th birthday. In order to receive the payment, you need to submit Genkyoh-Todoke every year. In the early June, Genkyo-Todoke forms for this year will be sent to the existing recipients. In order to receive the benefits, please make sure you send back (i) the form, (ii) a copy of health insurance card (if you are covered by employees' pension plan or mutual aid pension plan) and (iii) tax certificate and income certificate (if you were not registered as a resident of Sakura city as of January 1, 2016) in the enclosed return-addressed envelope. The form must arrive no later than June 30.

To help the residents enjoy long and healthy life, Sakura city has sent out Medical Interview Sheets and Health Checkup Slips to the eligible persons in late May. Various health checkups and cancer

screenings are available starting this month. Please do not miss this opportunity to get checked. Checkup Slips were sent to:

- Citizens with National Health Insurance aged at 40 and above
- Citizens aged at 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, or 70 (both male and female) as of March 31, 2017
- Citizens who took the city's health checkup in FY2015
- Citizens eligible for the vouchers for Cancer Screening offered by the Japanese government
- Citizens aged at 19, 25 or 30 (both male and female), or 20 or 35 (female only) as of March 31, 2017
- \*If you took the city's medical checkup, you cannot get subsidy for Ningen Dock. For details of Ningen Dock, please call: Kyuhfu Kanri-han,

28484-6604 (for NHI) or Kohreisha Iryoh-han 28484-6136 (Latter-Stage Elderly).



Please feel free to contact the counters shown above to consult about your family budget, job search and other comprehensive matters. The existing reception counter in the Sakura Work & Life Support Center (in Kaburagi-machi) continues to offer the services as in the past. Service hours for the both counters are: 8:30 – 17:15 on Weekdays.
