ANNUAL RENEWAL OF NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE CERTIFICATE

D National Health Insurance (NHI): Kenkoh Hoken-ka, 13484-6125 ② Kohki Kohreisha Iryc Hoken (Healthcare Insurance for Latter-Stage Elderly, KKHI): 13484-6136

Your certificate card of **①Kokumi Kenkoh Hoken (National Health Insurance, NHI)** or **②Kohki Kohreisha Iryoh Hoken (Healthcare Insurance for the Latter-Stage Elderly, KKHI)** is to be renewed shortly. A new certificate valid for one year from August 1, 2016 will be issued in mid-July and delivered to the insured by registered mail. If you were not at home when the new card was delivered, please make sure you receive it after calling the post office at the number shown on the delivery notice, and check if your personal particulars such as name, address, etc. are correctly recorded. (Then, please cut up and discard the old one.) The colors of the new certificates for NHI and KKHI are blue and orange respectively.

Gendogaku Tekiyo Nintelsho

"Gendogaku Tekiyo Ninteisho (Certificate for the application of the out-of-pocket maximum)" also expires after July 31. If you need it in and after August but didn't receive the new one with a new certificate, please make sure you take the necessary procedure for its renewal.

WHO NEEDS TO PAY THE INSURANCE TAX?

Kenkoh Hoken-ka, 12484-6125 (NHI) 12484-6136 (KKHI)

NHI: Even if the householder is not participating in NHI, he/she must pay the NHI tax if there is a family member who is covered by NHI.

The payment notice and the certificate card will be sent to the householder.

KKHI: Taxpayer is the person who is insured by KKHI. However, the spouse and the householder assume joint liability to pay the tax. The payment notice and the certificate card will be sent to the insured person.



WHAT IS NHI (NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE)?

Japan's health insurance system consists of two main programs: the National Health Insurance (NHI) and employer-sponsored health insurance.

All foreigners who have permission to stay in Japan for at least one year have to join one of these programs.

Please be sure you pay NHI insurance tax in time to avoid delinquency charge.

WHAT IS KOHKI KOHREISHA HEALTH INSURANCE?

All the elderlies aged 75 or above (and aged from 65 to 75 who have certain levels of disability) must enrol this insurance if you are staying in Jpapan more than three months. With the certificate, your out-of-pocket medical expense becomes 10% or 30% of the actual

cost depending on your income status.

Sending-out of Tax Payment Notice

Payment notices for NHI tax and KKHI premiums will be sent out in mid-July. In general, these tax and premiums are deducted from the payer's annuity if the taxpayer is a recipient of public annuity of 180,000 yen or more per year. However, there are cases where the payment should be made by payment slip or bank account transfer. You can change the payment method from "deduction from your annuity" into "bank transfer" if you want, by submitting an application form and an account transfer request document, but please note that it takes about three months.



Financial Support for Single-Parent Families



Jidoh Seisyohnen-ka (Children & Youth Section), 23484-6140

Sakura City provides various supports for single-parent families. Those who have been staying in Japan for prescribed minimum period are eligible. Those who have not claimed these benefits in the past because of the income limitations are recommended to review their income status. Please make sure not to miss your opportunities!

- 1. Child Rearing Allowance is provided to support single-parent (or marital parents with severe disability in either parent) families' financial independence and secure their lives. The period of payment is from the child birth to the first fiscal-year end (March 31) after the child's 18th year birthday (or until the day before the 20th birthday if the child has certain level of disability).
- **2. Sakura City Medical Expense Subsidy for Single-parent Families** is paid as part of the medical expenses of single parents and their children. The period of payment is the same as "1. Child Rearing Allowance."
- **3. Benefits for Single Parent's Educational Training** are paid as part of the tuition paid for the prescribed trainings of single parents to acquire skills or certificates for the purpose of getting a job.
- **4. Benefits for Single Parent's Higher Skills Training** is paid monthly for the period of training (must be one year or more) to obtain certificates for particular occupations such as nurse, dental hygienist, care worker, childcare worker, physiotherapist, occupational therapist, etc.
- **5. Benefits for Supporting Preparations for Passing the High-school Equivalency Certificate Test** are paid as part of the tuition paid by single parents or their children who are preparing to pass the high-school equivalency test.
- * "Single-parent families" are families in which children grow without one of the parents. All the above are subject to income limitations. Before you apply, please consult *Jidoh Seishohnen-ka* of Sakura City Hall.



approximately 4:00AM to 10:00AM as follows.

- * Date and time are subject to change in case of bad weather. In case there are any changes, we will let you know over loudspeakers, etc.
- 1. Refrain from entering or driving onto the districts on the date of the pest control.
- 2. Refrain from leaving food or drinking water outside in the subjected and nearby districts.
- **3.** If covers for vehicles or crops are necessary, please contact the Association in advance.
- 4. Refrain from entering the paddies for about five days after the day pesticides were sprayed.

<In case there is any problem...>

Should you accidentally inhale or be exposed to the pesticide, immediately rinse it away by gargling and using soap. Should any symptoms such as nausea appear, please call Shokubutsu Boh'eki Kyohkai, 2485-6188. ,.....

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE FOR MEDICAL EXPENSE SUBSIDY FOR CHILDREN

Jidoh Seishohnen-ka (Children & Youth Section), 12484-6140

Are you receiving subsidy from the "Children's Medical Expense Subsidy System"? Your eligibility certificate is to be renewed on August 1 every year. You will receive a new certificate on around July 25. When you receive the new certificate, please check if there is no error in your address, name, etc. Basically you don't need to take any procedure for the renewal, but if different out-of-pocket amount was notified between siblings in your household, please let us know. Also, you might receive a notification requesting submission of income/tax certificate. If you have filed or amended your tax return after July 1 this year, please submit a report of income change to *Jidoh Seishohnen-ka*.
