

Wadaiko is Japanese traditional drums famous for its powerful and intense sound. More than 20 groups of Wadaiko drummers get together at Kusabue-no-Oka during this two-day festival. You can enjoy their performance in the open air

According to IDF, 415 million adults were living with diabetes in 2015 and this number is rapidly growing with one in two adults with diabetes undiagnosed. 

When your child receives a medical treatment covered by health insurance, out-of-pocket expense will be no more than 200 yen if you present the Certificate at the medical institution. This subsidy program covers children until the age of 3rd grade of junior high school, and can be used for both outpatient and inpatient treatment (out-of-pocket expense will be \footnote{200} for one visit or one-day hospitalization, and drug dispensing will be free). Please apply for the certificate when you report the child's birth.
