Application for FY2017 enrollment in AFTER-SCHOOL DAYCARE CENTERS

Application acceptance for April 2017 enrollment in Gakudoh Hoikusho (after-school daycare center) will start shortly. Please apply at the daycare center in the period from January 10 to January 24, 2017. (At the time of application, you must attend an interview. For this interview, please make an appointment beforehand). Elementary school pupils whose parents/guardians are not available after school because of jobs, illnesses, etc., are eligible to enroll Gakudoh Hoikusho. In April 2017, Manodai Gakudoh Hoikusho and Someino Gakudoh Hoikusho will newly open in Manodai Elementary School and Someino Elementary School respectively, and the location of Sakurahigashi Gakudoh Hoikusho will move into Sakurahigashi Elementary School. Guidance leaflets for Gakudoh Hoikusho are available at the daycare centers, public nursery schools, Kosodate Shien-ka (Child Rearing Support Section) at the City Hall, and City branch offices. As for necessary documents for private centers, please contact the center directly. Please note that the children who have been accepted during this fiscal year also need to reapply if they wish to continue to stay in FY2017.

*The admission selection for April enrollment is made separately for each application period. Please note that the decision is <u>not</u> made in the order of application.

■ Method of Application:

When making application, please be accompanied by the enrolling child and bring the maternal handbook, health insurance certificate and your *Inkan* seal along with the following documents (forms must be filled out in advance).

*Application guidance leaflets are available at *Kosodate Shien-ka* in the City Hall, city branch offices, and the nursery schools.

■ Documents required:

Application forms, emergency contact list, medical interview sheet, certificate of employment, letter of consent, FY2016 tax documents, etc. (Please refer to the guidance leaflet for details.)

■ Place/Time of Acceptance:

- City Hall (Sanyo Room on the 1st floor of the Gikai wing, main building)
 Weekdays: 9:00 17:00 Sat. & Sun: 9:00 16:00
- Public nursery schools

Weekdays only: 9:00 - 16:00 (Reservation required)

What is Shokibo Hoikujigyo?

Shokibo Hoikujigyo is a small-scale regional childcare service carried out with the approval by the City. With this service, finely tuned childcare is provided for a group of children less than one year to roughly two years of age. The number of children should be 6 to 19.

What is the difference between Type A and B?

Type A: All the childcare workers must be certified.

Type B: Uncertified workers (limited to less than half of the staff) are allowed to give childcare after taking prescribed training.



INFLUENZA VACCINATION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

Kenkoh Kanri Center (the Health Management Center) 2485-6711

Influenza vaccination with public financial aid for senior citizens (aged 65 or over) will be over on December 31. In order to take advantage of this program, please make a reservation at a medical institution in Sakura City as soon as possible and get vaccinated at a reduced cost of 1,500 yen. An early shot is highly recommended to protect yourself during the peak flu season, because it takes about two weeks for antibodies to develop in your body. Before getting vaccinated, please fill out the vaccination slip you received earlier and
