NAGASHIMA Shigeo Memorial *Iwana* Baseball Stadium **Reopens after Major Upgrade**

On June 4, NAGASHIMA Shigeo Memorial Iwana Baseball Stadium will reopen after a major upgrade. The new stadium is equipped with a scoreboard with a big monitor that can display moving images in full color in addition to the inning scores and players' names. All the lights has been converted to LED and with the six floodlights, night games can be enjoyed as before. The upgraded stand accommodates new seats for wheelchairs and increased number of multipurpose toilets. Citizens can use the stadium from September upon reservations, which can be

made on and after July 1.

In early June every year, the iris garden in the Sakura Castle Site Park is filled with elegant iris flowers in purple, yellow, white, and many other mixed colors. Visitors can enjoy the beautiful view with some 9,000 plants of about 50 species of irises in a natural setting. In the Ubagaike pond next to the iris garden, water lilies will also bloom on the water surface. Please Submit GENKYO TODOKE (Current Status Report) No later than June 30 to fully receive your Child Allowance ("Jidō Teate")

Under Japanese child allowance system, every household raising a child in Japan is eligible for financial support by the government until the first March 31st after the child's 15th birthday. In order to receive the payment, recipients need to submit Genkyō-Todoke (Current Status Report) every year. In early June, Genkyō-Todoke forms for this year will be sent to the existing recipients. Please send back (i) the form, (ii) a copy of health insurance card (if you are covered by employees' pension plan or mutual aid pension plan) and (iii) tax certificate and income certificate (if you are not registered as a resident of Sakura City as of January 1, 2017) in the enclosed return-addressed envelope. The form must be postmarked no later than June 30.

As one of the preparation efforts for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and Paralympics, a training course for volunteer interpreter guides will be offered for free at the Millennium Center Sakura in July. The course contents include: mental attitude as an interpreter, intercultural communication, unique characteristics and attractiveness of Chiba Prefecture, and role playing in English. Participants must be 18 years of age at youngest and willing to register as a Language Volunteer of Chiba International Center (CIC) to support foreign tourists, and have conversationallevel English proficiency. To help the citizens enjoy a long and healthy life, Sakura City has sent out Health Checkup Slips and Medical Interview Sheets to the eligible people in late May. Kinds of medical checkups and cancer screenings are available starting this month. Please do not miss this opportunity.

Health Checkup Slips have been sent to:

- Citizens covered by National Health Insurance (NHI) and aged 40 years and upward
- Citizens aged 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, or 70 years (both male and female) as of March 31, 2018
- Citizens who took the city's health checkup in FY2016
- Citizens eligible for the vouchers for Cancer Screening offered by the Japanese government
- Male and female citizens aged 19, 25 or 30 years, or female citizens aged 20 or 35 years as of March 31, 2018

*Those who took *Tokutei Kenshin* cannot get the city subsidy for Ningen Dock. For details of Ningen Dock, please call Kenko Hoken-ka at 2484-6604 (NHI) or 2484-6136 (Latter-Stage Elderly).

Eligibility for FREE Checkups

- ① Those who are aged 70 years and upward as of March 31, 2018
- (2) Those who are covered by the medical insurance for Latter-Stage Elderly (*Kōki-kōreisha*) Healthcare System
- ③ Those who are on public assistance^(*)
- ④ Those who belong to households exempt from city taxes^(*)

(*)In cases (3) and (4), application is required three weeks prior to the checkup date at latest for a free checkup.

Please make sure to bring your Health Checkup Slip (Kenshin-Jushin-Ken), Medical Interview Sheet, health insurance certificate and checkup fee*. *: Checkup fee must be paid by cash at the venue.
