## The 30th Sakura Tulip Festival

April 4 to April 25 (9:00 - 16:00) at Sakura Furusato Hiroba Square

Spring has come, and again it's the season to enjoy the carpet of tulips at Furusato Hiroba beside Imbanuma Lake, where Sakura's landmark Dutch windmill 'De Liefde' is located.

The festival is going to be one of the largest in the Kanto region with some 670,000 tulips of 100 varieties. Along the sideway, lots of stalls will be selling food, drinks and local products during the festival. A variety of events and fun activities are waiting for you!

- **Short test rides of Dutch bicycles** (April 21 & 22, free of charge)





Access to the Venue As heavy traffic jams are foreseen and the parking lots are limited around the festival site, you are requested to take the special bus or the regular city bus (both from Keisei Sakura station - about 10 min. to the venue) for the event, whenever feasible. Bus fare is ¥100/ride.

On foot, it takes about 40 minutes from Keisei Sakura or Usui stations.



\* On weekends, significant congestion is expected. Weekday visits are strongly recommended.

## Cherry Blossoms in Sakura Castle Site Park

Event Period: April 3 – 8 (10:00–16:00)

Sakura Castle Site Park is one of the most popular hanami spots in Sakura. At this site there once had been a castle that is now listed as one of the Japan's Top 100 Castles, being the only one in Chiba Prefecture. In the park, you can see about 1,100 cherry trees of roughly 50 varieties, including 13 varieties of cherry blossoms which have been famous since the Edo period. Throughout the event period, food, local produce, sweets, drinks, etc. will be available at stalls set up in the park. Also, on April 7 (~15:00), matcha green tea with sweets will be served for ¥400 under the big cherry tree in front of the museum restaurant.



#### MASS VACCINATION OF DOGS AGAINST RABIFS

Unregistered dogs can be registered at the venue for an additional 3,000 yen registration fee. In case you are unable to come on the mass vaccination day, you must get your dog vaccinated at an animal clinic, and submit the vaccination report to the city.

#### NOTES

- Vaccinations cannot be administered in the following cases: ① The dog is registered in another city, and the owner has not yet completed the procedure for moving into Sakura City; ② The dog received a different kind of vaccination less than 30 days before; ③ The dog experienced serious side effects after a vaccination in the past; ④ The dog is in mating season, pregnant, breast-feeding, or under 91 days of age; ⑤ The dog cannot be kept calm or under control.
- Please don't visit by car, since parking lots are not available, other than at Iwana Sports Park.
- Make sure to take your pet's droppings home.
- If it's raining, please bring towels to dry your dog.
- Unclothe your pet when getting the vaccination.
- You are required to report any changes in your dog's registration (change of owner, address, etc.).
   Also, when your dog dies, you need to file a death notice to have the record cancelled.

(\*If a weather warning is issued, mass vaccinations on the day will be cancelled.)



## ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS Kyōiku Sōmu-ka (General Educational Affairs Section) 25484-6182

The city grants scholarships to senior high school students who meet all the following conditions. Successful applicants are granted a scholarship of up to 80,000 yen in a fiscal year.

- 1. Lives in Sakura City;
- 2. Entered senior high school in the year of graduation from junior high school, or in the following year;
- 3. Motivated to learn, and has earned a grade point average (GPM) of three or more on the five-grade evaluation system during the third year of junior high school;
- 4. Family income in the previous year was less than 1.3 times the maximum income eligibility level for public assistance, and deemed to have financial difficulties in attending senior high school in this fiscal year;
- 5. Have a recommendation letter from the principal of the junior high school from which the student graduated. Application acceptance starts on Monday, April 2 and the deadline (for starting the payment of the grant in April) is Tuesday, May 1. For later applications, the grant cannot be paid for the month(s) before the application.

(Please note that if the high school enrollment support fund by Chiba Prefecture is paid at the same time, the equivalent amount will be subtracted from the city scholarship.)

#### CITY PARKING LOTS FOR BICYCLES & MOTORCYCLES

12 bicycle parking lots are made available by the city around 6 train stations in Sakura. Applications for year-round use (until March 31, 2019) are now being accepted at each parking lot. Also, temporary use is available for \$100/day for a bicycle and \$210 /day for a moped or scooter (up to 125cc displacement). The lots are open 24h/day.

#### POPULATION OF SAKURA CITY

As of the end of February, the population of Sakura City was 176,180 (86,839 males and 89,341 females) in 76,667 households. The total includes 3,025 registered non-Japanese residents.

### City Subsidies for Ningen Dock/Nou Dock for those covered by NHI

Kenkō Hoken-ka, & 484-6604 (National Health Insurance) & 484-6136 (Medical insurance for the elderly)

For Ningen Dock (comprehensive physical exams) and Nou Dock (brain scans) gotten by registered residents 20 years old or over who are insured by NHI (National Health Insurance) or the Latter- Stage Elderly Healthcare System, half of the cost (with a limit of 10,000 yen each) will be covered by the city, upon request. The application must be received no later than March 29, 2019. Please apply as soon as a reservation for the exam is made.

- Ningen Dock that covers all the checkup items designated in Tokutei Kenshin is subject to this subsidy if one didn't get Tokutei Kenshin by the city during this fiscal year (April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019).
- Nou Dock using both MRI and MRA is subject to this subsidy if Ningen Dock or Tokutei Kenshin is gotten in the same fiscal year.

### Start of Subsidized Vaccinations (for FY 2018: April 1, 2018 - March 31, 2019)

Kenkō Kanri Center, 🔁 485-6711

When using vaccination slips issued by the city, eligible residents will get subsidies for the following vaccinations during this fiscal year. For eligibility details, please call the center.

#### [Pneumococcal vaccinations for the elderly]

Out-of-pocket cost will be only 3,000 yen, owing to the subsidy from the city.

#### [Measles & Rubella vaccinations for infants]

Free M & R vaccinations should be taken twice during infancy. [Japanese encephalitis (JE) vaccinations for those born Apr. 2, 1998 – Apr. 1, 2007]

Those born during the above period who missed at least one chance of JE vaccinations due to the temporary suspension of the government's recommendation for it, are now eligible for the vaccination(s) free of charge. Those wishing to get it should bring their/child's maternal handbook to any city health center.
