## PROTECTING THE LIVES AND SECURITY OF THE CITIZENS

The Firefighting Association consists of two cities and one town: Sakura City, Yachimata City and Shisui Town. In Sakura City, in addition to the Fire Department, there are two fire stations and four branch offices. The Fire Brigade's Emergency System consists of an emergency department which includes 90 paramedics who have completed qualified training and have specialized knowledge.

#### Firefighting Communication System

Since April 2013 and in addition to the Sakura-Yachimata-Shisui Firefighting Association, 19 fire station headquarters in the north-eastern and southern parts of Chiba Prefecture receive communication commands (119 calls, dispatching of fire engines and ambulances, wireless communications, etc.) collectively operated by the Chiba Fire Defense Joint Command Center located in the Chiba City Fire Department. As a result, we are able to streamline operations, collaborate with each fire department and share information as well as strengthen the mutual support system for adjacent areas and large-scale disasters.




## Ambulances and medical services are limited resources, let's use them wisely!

Ambulances can be delivered almost instantly to people in need. In recent years, however, the number of ambulance dispatches as well as the number of people transported have increased, so the arrival time to the field by ambulance crews has been subject to delay. There are also situations when about half of the people transported by ambulance actually do not need to be hospitalized. If you have life threatening symptoms related to heart or brain diseases, call an ambulance without hesitation. Early notification, proper treatment by the ambulance staff and early transportation to a hospital can be lifesaving and reduce the after-effects of the sick and injured, ensuring a prompt rehabilitation.

#### Prevention of heat stroke is important!

Please be careful as the number of heat stroke victims increases during the hot season. Heat stroke causes various symptoms such as



If you or another person show heat stroke symptoms, move to a shaded area or air-conditioned room, loosen the clothes and keep the body cool around the neck, armpits and feet. If possible, drink an oral rehydrating solution. Do not hesitate to call an ambulance if the person is unconscious and can't receive proper rehydration.

- ◆If you are uncertain whether to call an ambulance, there is a free medical telephone consultation service provided by Chiba Prefecture. Emergency telephone consultations for 15 years and older as well as consultations for sudden illnesses in children under 15 years-old are provided. The consultation is free of charge but call charges are to be paid by the users.
- ◆Nationwide medical emergency app "Qsuke". By accessing this application, you can quickly determine the symptoms' urgency. The standard basis for calling an ambulance is indicated. \*There is an item related to heat stroke.
- ◆Leaflet "Let's deepen our knowledge related to urgencies". If you have a sudden illness or injury, select the appropriate symptom on the screen and the required response according to the urgency will be displayed. You can call 119, search for a medical institution and search for medical examination.

The application deadline to receive the "Special Fixed Benefit" is approaching. Every person eligible for the benefit will receive an amount of ¥ 100,000 so please be sure to apply within the deadline.

Who is eligible for payment? Persons who live or have moved in to Sakura City as of April 27, 2020 and who have been registered in the Basic Resident Register of Sakura City as of the reference date. People who have moved in to Sakura City after the reference date should contact the municipality that had the resident registration.

\* Please be careful of transfer frauds (furikome-sagi) and fraud of personal information.

Please submit your current status report (Genkyō-Todoke) to receive the Special Child Rearing Allowance (Jidō Fuyō Teate) & Medical Expense Subsidies for Single-Parent Families

Genkyō Todoke (the current status report) for receiving Jidō Fuyō Teate (special child-rearing allowances) is being accepted from August 3 (Mon) - August 31 (Mon) (except weekends and national holidays). Please note that failure to submit the report may result in termination of the allowance payments. The report submission must be done in person at the City Hall. XAn interview will be carried out to confirm the current situation. However, if you are qualified only for the Medical Expense Subsidies for Single-Parent Families, you can submit the report by post. Also, please submit the green document (Partial Suspension Exemption Reason Notification Form) and other papers if you have received them. For those who have not been certified, a new certification request is required.

Support measures related to the new coronavirus infection Temporary benefits will be provided to single parent households, families receiving child rearing allowances, etc. who are particularly vulnerable and whose living and employment situations may have been affected due to school closures, schools and business leaves, etc. The period to apply starts August 3 (Mon) until February 26, 2021(Fri). An application may or may not be required so please contact the Children & Youth Section for details and eligibility.

Before your appointed health checkup, measure your body temperature. If your temperature is 37.5°C or higher, if you have symptoms such as cough, sore throat, runny nose, breathlessness, headache, joint pain, diarrhea, taste disorder or strong dullness, please refrain from visiting the clinic as you may be refused medical examination. Please cooperate with infection prevention measures such as wearing a mask, hand washing and hand disinfection. Depending on the situation of the new coronavirus infection, there is a possibility of suspending the health checkups. Please visit the city's website for updates.

#### POINTS THAT WILL BE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

- (1) All mass screenings with the exception of colon cancer have been changed to a full appointment system.
- → From August 3 (Monday), appointments for specific medical checkups: chest X-ray, stomach cancer & hepatitis will be accepted on a lottery basis.
- →From October 1 (Thursday), appointments for breast cancer and cervical cancer will be accepted on a firstcome, first-served basis.
- ② Multiple screenings carried out in one day have also been changed and divided into two groups: First group: Specific medical examination (medical checkup), chest X-ray, colon cancer & hepatitis. Second group: Stomach cancer & colon cancer. \*Reservation is not required for colon cancer examination. You can submit the stool collection
- container to either 1st or 2nd group. (Please contact us in advance if you don't have the container).
- 3 The checkup scheduled has been modified.
- → First group: The morning time will start earlier and an afternoon time has been added.
- → <u>Second group</u>: The checkup schedule has been added, the morning time will start earlier.
- \*There is no change in schedule and time for breast cancer and cervical cancer.



## Subsidized mouth cancer screening

Acceptance of applications for city-subsidized mouth cancer screening starts on September 1, 2020 (Tue) for Sakura City residents. If detected early, people with mouth cancer have a very high cure rate so please take this important screening by all means! In order to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus infection, collective screenings at Happy Chewing Fair have been cancelled. To apply for individual screenings, please call the section in charge. A consultation ticket and questionnaire will be sent to your home. Please make a reservation at any of the cooperating dental clinics. \*A person can take only one subsidized screening in one fiscal year. Individual screening Reservation

Eligibility: Residents aged 40 years or older (as of March 31, 2021)

Period available: September 1, 2020 (Tuesday) until February 10, 2021 (Wednesday)

Place: Cooperating dental clinics in Sakura City (39 in total) **Up to:** 350 applicants on a first-come, first-served basis.

Consultation fee\*: 400 yen (+ additional 300 yen if cytological diagnosis is needed) Free for citizens who are ① Aged 70 years or older ② Chiba Prefecture medical insured senior 3 Belonging to a household that is receiving social welfare or exempt from city tax.
