LET'S BE CAREFUL ABOUT HEAT STROKES

A heat stroke occurs when the body's thermoregulatory system does not function properly and heat is trapped inside the body, such as in a hot environment. This happens especially in July after the rainy season as it is hot and humid and the body is not yet used the heat. The number of emergency transportation and casualties due to heat stroke is increasing year by year, so let's get the right knowledge to prevent this condition. Please give particular attention to those days when:

- **☼**The temperature is above the 28℃
- The time when it starts getting hot.
- The day after a sweltering night.
- Humidity is 70% or more.
- When suddenly it gets hot.
- It's a windless day.

5 POINTS TO CONSIDER TO PREVENT A HEAT STROKE:

• HAVING A GOOD BALANCE BETWEEN HEAT STROKE AND CORONAVIRUS MEASURES.



Wearing a mask makes it difficult for heat to escape through the skin and before you know it, you may be dehydrated and have difficulty regulating your body temperature. Depending on your physical condition, remove the mask if you can maintain a sufficient distance (2m or more) from people outdoors.

PHYSICAL SENSATION TO ESTIMATE THE TEMPERATURE. Check indoor conditions with a thermo-hygrometer, not the temperature setting of the air conditioner. As a guide, use an air conditioner or fan with a room temperature of 28°C or less and humidity of 70% or less.

3 TAKE PRECAUTIONS WHEN GOING OUTDOORS.

Avoid hot days and hot hours and carry out your activities within moderate limits. When outside, wear cool, well-ventilated clothing and a parasol or hat to avoid the heat.

◆ DRINK PLENTY OF FLUIDS BEFORE YOU FEEL THIRSTY.
Even if you don't feel thirsty, rehydrate frequently with 1.2 ~ 1.5L daily as a guide. Please consult with your doctor if you have heart or kidney diseases.

• TAKE CARE OF YOUR HEALTH ON A DAILY BASIS. Let's keep in mind a well-balanced diet and physical fitness.

THE CHILDREN AND THE ELDERLY NEED SPECIAL ATTENTION

About 40% of heat strokes occur indoors. In households with small children and the elderly who have chronic illnesses or disabilities, use air conditioner appropriately. Please adjust it so that the wind doesn't hit directly.

◆ To prevent heat stroke, the Ministry of Environment provides information on the Heat Index (WBGT) which indicates the susceptibility to heat stroke.

When the risk of heat stroke is predicted to be extremely high, a warning alert is announced by prefecture. In Sakura City, this information is posted on the official Twitter "Like! Sakura City".

Genkyō Todoke (the current status report) for receiving Jidō Fuyō Teate (special child-rearing allowances) is being accepted from August 1 (Mon) ~ August 31 (Wed) (except weekends and national holidays).

If you received the notice after the end of June, it is also necessary to submit the enclosed green document (Partial Suspension Exemption Reason Notification Form) and other papers if you have received them.

(Please note that failure to submit the report may result in termination of the allowance payments.

For those who have not been certified, a new certification request is required.

The report submission must be done in person at the City Hall. X An interview will be carried out to confirm the current situation. However, if you are qualified only for the Medical Expense Subsidies for Single-Parent Families, you can submit the report by post.

Subsidized Mouth Cancer Screening



Kenkō Suishin-ka (Health Promotion Division) 2 312-8228

Reservation required

Acceptance of applications for city-subsidized mouth cancer screening starts on September 1, 2022 at your local dentist's clinic and for Sakura City residents. Collective screenings at Happy Chewing Fair have been cancelled to prevent the coronavirus infection spread. To apply for individual screenings, you can do it in either of the following ways: ① Through the website (QR above), ② By phone, please call the Health Promotion Division. ③ At the window of Kenkō Kanri Center. A consultation ticket and questionnaire will be sent to your home. Please make a reservation at any of the cooperating dental clinics. ※The mouth cancer screening is not included in the examination ticket set that is delivered in an orange envelope. For this particular screening application is required.

Eligibility: Residents aged 40 years or older (as of March 31, 2023).

*Those who are currently being treated for oral cancer or under observation do not apply.

Period available: From September 1, 2022 (Thursday) until February 10, 2023 (Friday).

Place: Cooperating dental clinics in Sakura City (42 in total) **Up to:** 330 applicants on a first-come, first-served basis.

3 Belonging to a household that is receiving social welfare or exempt from the city tax.

Is there any internal inflammation that does not heal after more than 2 weeks?

It is recommended that you check your mouth regularly, especially if you have persistent mouth ulcers, if you smoke, drink alcohol, have dentures or dentures that do not fit. Oral cancer can occur on all mucosa, including the tongue, between the tongue and the gums and the inside of the cheek. If detected early, people with mouth cancer have a very high cure rate so please take this important screening by all means!
