In general, inquiries can be answered in English on **Wednesdays**, in Spanish on **Thursdays** and in Chinese on **Fridays**, through $K\bar{o}h\bar{o}$ -ka, City Hall. Except for these days, questions can be answered only in Japanese at City Hall and/or other city facilities. Therefore, when making inquiries, please be accompanied by someone who speaks Japanese as needed.

With the Dutch windmill as a background, more than 500,000 cosmos flowers will be in full bloom during the festival at Sakura Furusato Hiroba Square. Visitors can cut or dig up flowers for purchase: 100 Yen / five cosmos plants or 300 Yen / one plastic bag, meaning as many flowers/plants as you can put in the bag.

◆ Access: Temporary shuttle busses will operate only on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays from Keisei Sakura Station at the North Exit, the fare is 220 Yen. Community buses will also be departing from the same exit, the fare is 200 Yen. It takes 10 minutes to the venue.

◆ Bicycle rentals: Available at any of the following places: ●Sakura-shi Kankō Kyōkai (near Keisei Sakura St.) ●Kankō Jōhō Center (at the north exit of JR Sakura Station) ●At the festival venue ●San-San Cycle (near Keisei Usui Station, south exit. ● Aeon-Lakepia Usui. The rental fees are: 500 Yen per day or 1,000 Yen for an electric bicycle. (It is possible to return the bicycle at a different place but a fee will apply).

For enrollment in April 2023, applications for kindergartens are going to be accepted as per the following schedule.

Municipal kindergartens

- Duration of education and children accepted:
- ① **2-year education** for 4 year-old children born on or between April 2, 2018 and April 1, 2019
- ② 1-year education for 5 year-old children born on or between April 2, 2017 and April 1, 2018
- ♦ How to apply: The *application* period starts Oct. 17 (Mon) until Nov. 4 (Fri). The *registration* period starts Nov. 1 (Tue) until Nov. 4 (Fri) ※Consultation required after the period ends. When making an application, please visit the kindergarten with the child for whom you are applying. Make sure to bring your *inkan* (family seal) and Jūmin-hyō (certificate of residence) that shows the relationship of all the family members in the household to which the child belongs. Jūmin-hyō can be obtained at Shimin-ka (the Registration & Certification Services Section) of City Hall.

Private kindergartens

Duration of education and children accepted:

- 3-year education for 3-year old children born on or between April 2, 2019 and April 1, 2020
- 2-year education for 4-year old children born on or between April 2, 2018 and April 1, 2019
- 1-year education for 5-year old children born on or between April 2, 2017 and April 1, 2018
- Application guidebooks and forms are distributed at ② & ③ kindergartens from Oct. 15 (Sat) and at ① & ④ kindergartens from Oct. 17 (Mon).

Reservations for collective breast & cervical cancer screenings are being accepted from October 3 (Mon) first-come, first-served. The reception will be closed as soon as the capacity is reached.

CANCER SCREENINGS ELIGIBLE TARGETS:

✦ Breast cancer screening: Women 30 years and older who did not undergo collective examination as well as mammography screening in the previous fiscal year. The examination will be conducted as follows:

- Group in their 30's will receive an ultrasound examination.
- Group in their 40's will have a two-ways mammography examination.
- Group in their 50's and above will have a one-way mammography examination.

Cervical cancer screening: Women 20 years and older who did not take this screening in the previous fiscal year.
 How to make a reservation: Please send a postcard, fax, through the internet or at the counter of any of the city's health centers. Please check the schedule, venue and details of time of reservation in the city homepage or in the Sakura City Examination Information enclosed in your Health Checkup slip. XA consultation ticket is required for the examination. If you have not received the consultation ticket, please contact the Kenkō Kanri Center. XIn order to prevent the spread of coronavirus infections, *the childcare service will be discontinued.* The staff will take care of the children while participants to the screenings are tested in the bus.

LOW-COST INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS

The low-cost program of influenza vaccinations for senior citizens starts on October 1 and will be available through December 31, 2022. Flu symptoms may become more severe in older people. Getting vaccinated before the flu epidemic begins is effective and highly recommended.

From this fiscal year, there are no restrictions on the interval between the coronavirus vaccine and the influenza vaccine but please note that the interval between these and other vaccinations should be of at least 2 weeks.

• Citizens aged 65 years and over, those born between October 2, 1957 ~ January 1, 1958. It is possible to vaccinate on the day prior to your birthday *on the dates indicated*. Aside from those dates, you will be responsible for the full vaccination amount.

O Citizens aged 60-64 years who have a 'Physical Disability Certificate' (Level 1) due to heart, kidney, respiratory diseases, etc. (A prior call is necessary for those in this group who would like to receive the vaccination.)

Eligible people can inoculate at a reduced cost of 1,500 yen at any cooperative medical institution in Sakura City as well as in Chiba Prefecture. (※Free for citizens on welfare. Please obtain a Welfare Recipient Certificate in advance at the City Hall, *Shakai Fukushi-ka* (the Social Welfare Section) and bring it to the medical institution on the vaccination day.

LET'S GET A COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING ONCE A YEAR.

Kenkō Suishin-ka (Health Promotion Section 2485-6711



In 2021, colorectal cancer was detected in the screenings of 25 people in Sakura City. In Japan, one in two people will be diagnosed with cancer and one in three people will die. Colorectal cancer is the number one cause of death in women and the third in men. Early colorectal cancer has no subjective symptoms, but with early detection and treatment, more than 95% of patients are cured. Therefore, it is important to have regular screenings even if you do not have subjective symptoms.

- Target people: Those 40 years old or above as of March 31, 2023.
- Individual examination: Until December 10 at cooperating medical institutions. Reservation required. Fee: 1,000 Yen.
- Collective checkup: Until March 9, 2023 at an a assigned examination location. Fee: 400 Yen. For checkup dates, venues, etc. please visit the website.
 Stool containers are distributed at the counter of each health center when undergoing collective screenings. In the case of individual examination, please pick up the container at the medical institution of your choice.
