In general, inquiries can be answered in English on **Wednesdays**, in Spanish on **Thursdays** and in Chinese on **Fridays**, through  $K\bar{o}h\bar{o}$ -ka, City Hall. Except these days, questions can be answered only in Japanese at City Hall and/or other city facilities. Therefore, when making inquiries, please be accompanied by someone who speaks Japanese as needed.



From this year the following changes have been implemented. Please take note of them before submitting your tax return documents.

- The City Hall has stopped preparation assistance and accepting submissions of final income tax returns (Kakutei Shinkoku) as well as Municipal/Prefectural tax returns.
- Tax returns preparation and submissions will be accepted at the Central Public Hall (Chūo Kominkan). The procedures cannot be carried out on Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays and on Mondays.

#### Distribution of Tax Return Forms (Until March 15)

From January 25 (Wed) the forms are being distributed at the City Hall on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor lobby of the main building as well as at each branch office, dispatch offices and service centers. From February 16 (Thur), the income tax return and residence tax forms are being distributed at the Chūō Kōminkan (Central Community Hall). (For those who submitted the prefectural tax return last year, the tax return was sent out on January 25 (Wed). The number of forms is limited so they can also be downloaded from the National Tax Agency (Kokuzeichō) https://www.nta.go.jp/

### Who needs to file a tax return?

#### \*INCOME TAX - Inquiries: Narita Tax Office, ☎0476-28-5151\*

#### People in any of the following situations must file an income tax return:

- 1. The person's total employment income in 2022 was more than 20 million yen
- 2. Received a salary from only one employer, and the total of various kinds of non-salary income was more than 200,000 yen in 2022.
- 3. Received a salary from two or more employers, and the total amount of "(income not subject to the year-end adjustment) + (various kinds of income, besides salary and/or retirement income)" was more than 200,000 yen in 2022.
- 4. Income tax has not been withheld from the person's monthly salary, yet he/she has earned a taxable level of income in 2022.
- 5. The balance of "(total income in 2023)—(income deduction)" gives a positive amount\*
  ※ If the "Income from Public Annuities, etc." was 4 million yen or less and other "Miscellaneous Income" was 200,000 yen or less, a tax filing is not required. This shall not be applied if annuities from overseas are included. However, please note that you may receive a tax refund depending on the declaration.

#### People in either of the following situations do not need to file an income tax return:

- 1. All income was from a salary, and the year-end adjustment has been made by the employer; or
- 2. No income was subject to income tax (for example, survivor's pension and unemployment insurance benefits are not taxable).

#### \*RESIDENCE TAX – Shiminzei-Ka (Municipal Tax Section) of Sakura City Hall, ☎484-6115\*

Anyone registered as a Sakura citizen as of January 1, 2023 and meets any of the following conditions must file a residence tax return:

- 1. An unemployed person with business income (e.g. from sales, agriculture, real estate, etc.) less than the minimum income tax filing requirement
- 2. A salary earner who also had an income of 200,000 yen or less from sources other than salary

#### Recommended to declare but not required:

- 1. Those who are dependent on another household.
- 2. Those who did not have income during the previous year 2022 and were not dependent on anyone (The tax return also serves as calculation data for national health insurance tax fee and medical insurance premiums for the elderly in the latter stages.
- 3. Those who have a deduction for city and prefectural taxes.
- On the other hand, those who meet any of the following conditions <u>do not need</u> to file a residence tax return:
  - 1. Have already filed or will file an income tax return.
  - All income was from one salary and a payroll report has already been submitted to the City Hall by the employer.
  - A dependent family member listed on the tax return form or payroll report of any other member in the same household.



### **TAX RETURN FILING VENUES**

◆During this period, tax return preparation and consultation at the Narita Tax Office will not be provided.

Aeon Mall is open from 10 AM. If you arrive before, please enter from the parking area connecting passage located on the  $3^{rd}$  floor.

◆Buses are expected to be especially busy on the first day and on the last week. <Bus information> Take the Chiba Kotsu bus "AEON MALL bound" from Platform 6 at the Central Exit (West Exit) of Keisei Narita Station. It takes about 10 minutes to arrive at the mall.

◆ To alleviate congestion, an admission numbered ticket is required and depending on the distribution status, reception may be closed early. These are distributed at the venue on the day of the event or obtained in advance with an assigned date and time by adding a friend to the NTA official account of LINE app.

**Service:** Assistance with preparation and submission of income and residence tax return filings.

\*Admission to the venue may be restricted. Depending on the congestion situation, we may ask you to come to the venue at a later date. The first day is usually crowded, so please avoid coming on the first day if possible. Depending on the spread of the new coronavirus infection, preparation, consultation and submission at the declaration venue may be canceled. In case of cancellation, the city will inform through its website.

※Please note that this office does not have a tax preparation venue from Feb. 6 (Mon) ∼ March 15 (Wed).

Please note that assistance in preparation of the following items is provided only at AEON MALL Narita. Chūō Kominkan cannot handle preparation on them.

•Those with income other than salary or public pension (excluding personal belongings). •Special deduction for housing loans, etc. (excluding those already adjusted at the end of the year). •Declaration of lost earnings. •Declaration of foreign tax credit. •Declaration of donation deduction other than hometown tax. •Declaration of income related to sales, agriculture, real estate, interest, dividends, transfers, temporary income and retirement income. •Declaration of future transactions. •Declaration of gift tax and consumption tax. •Quasi-final return (deceased/moved abroad). •Declarations for 2021 or before. •Other declarations with complex calculations or declarations requiring judgment by the tax office.

### What documents are needed for filing?

When filing a tax return, you will need:

▶Your individual number (My Number) A copy from both sides is needed.

#### For those who don't have My Number card:

►A document verifying your individual number such as the notification card (Tsūchi card) or copy of the resident certificate (Jūmin-hyō). Any of them showing the individual number.

▶ Personal identification documents: show any of the following documents that verify your identity such as driver's license, passport, pension book (Nenkin techō), Health insurance card (Kenkō Hokenshō), disability card (Shogaisha techō).

### PLEASE DO NOT BURN GARBAGE OUTDOORS!

Open-burning is prohibited under the Waste Disposal and Public Cleansing Law (There are some exceptions such as customary events).

Not only commercial garbage but also household garbage (daily garbage, pruned branches, grass from vegetable gardens, etc.) is not allowed to be incinerated outdoors.

We ask you for your cooperation in the proper disposal of garbage.

Sakura City sponsors an inexpensive insurance program (*Sakura-shi Saigai Kyōsai*) that offers its residents a certain level of coverage for personal injuries, death, and damage to residential buildings due to fire, lightning strike, gas explosion, storm wind, heavy rain, tornado, flood, etc. ◆Damage caused by earthquake, snowfall, hailstorm or decrepit condition is <u>not</u> covered; <u>nor</u> is damage to machinery and related equipment, electrical appliances, etc.) ◆A head of a household who is registered as a Sakura resident is eligible to enroll in this cooperative insurance, regardless of nationality.

**Insurance premium & period:** Costs ¥1,000 per household for the period starting on April 1, 2023 or the day following the actual application day, whichever is later. The insurance period ends on March 31, 2024. The application period starts on February 1 (Wednesday).

### SPECIAL BENEFITS FOR CHILD-REARING FAMILIES

Due to the impact of the new coronavirus infectious disease, the government will support low-income child-rearing households that are facing difficulties due to soaring prices of food and other items. In addition, Sakura City will provide its own benefits to households that are not eligible for government benefits and meet the necessary requirements (an application may be required).

For details on application guidelines and documents, please refer to the city website.

Application deadline: February 28 (Tuesday)

Amount of benefit: 50,000 Yen %National benefits and city's specific benefits cannot be paid together.

*Eligibility:* Parents raising children born on or after April 2, 2004 (Children with disabilities who are under 20 years old).

► Those who fall under any of the following:

<National benefits> Whether the resident tax is exempted in FY 2022, those households whose finances changed suddenly due to the impact of the new coronavirus infection and those whose expected income for one year after the sudden change are at a level equivalent to exemption from resident tax. Those who have not received the child-rearing allowance for April 2022 due to receiving a public pension, etc.

<City's specific benefits> Those who pay only per capita resident tax.

Those living in Sakura City at the time of application as of March 31, 2022. Parents to raise a newborn child due from March 1 ~ April 1, 2023.
