ACCESS

- By car: 30 minutes from Higashi Kantō Yotsukaido IC / Sakura IC. Parking space for 500 vehicles is available around the venue: Passenger car: 1,000 Yen.

 ◆ By bus: From Keisei Sakura Station to the venue you can take either the community bus for 200 Yen (Arrives in 10 minutes) or the special shuttle Chiba Green Bus for 220 Yen (Arrives in 15 minutes).

CHIBA PREFECTURAL GENERAL ELECTION OF COUNCIL MEMBERS

Election day: April 9 (Sun) 7:00 ~ 20:00 Who can vote?

- ♦ Those born by April 10, 2005, have reported resident registration to Sakura City by December 30, 2022 and are registered on the electoral list.
- ♦ Those who have an address in the prefecture uninterruptedly until the day of the election day. If notification of transference was done after December 31, 2022 cannot vote in Sakura City. If you have moved in from another municipality in the prefecture, you can vote at your previous location if you are registered on the electoral list. For details, please contact the Election Administration Commission of your previous address.

SAKURA CITY MAYOR ELECTION – SAKURA CITY GENERAL ELECTION OF COUNCIL MEMBERS Election day: April 23 (Sun) 7:00 ~ 20:00

Details will be provided on the April 15 edition of Kōhō Sakura.

EARLY VOTING:

If you are unable to vote on the election day, please use the anticipated voting system. Voting hours vary by polling place. There is no designation of early voting election place based on address, etc. Any early voting location is available.

- •For Chiba Prefectural General Election of Council Members: April 1 (Sat) ~ April 8 (Sat).
- ●For Sakura City Mayor Election Sakura City General Election of Council Members: April 17 (Mon) ~ April 22 (Sat).

- ▶Sakura City Hall, at the second building, 1st. Floor.

CORONAVIRUS INFECTION UPDATE

- On April 10 (Monday), a new reservation system for the coronavirus vaccination will start.
- ◆ Reservation available date for vaccination is on May 1 (Monday)
 Change No. 1 My Page registration.

When you log in for the first time, you will be required to register your vaccination information: Your name in katakana, telephone number. You can register on My Page with the corona vaccine ticket number that you have received from the city so far, and if you register in advance, you can make a reservation smoothly.

Change No. 2 Delivery of reservation confirmation email. If you register your email address on My Page (optional), you can make a reservation or cancel it. You will receive a confirmation email when you do it. In addition, we will notify you by email when the vaccination date is approaching.

Change No. 3 Enhanced search function.

In addition to dates and districts, you can refine your search by vaccine type and venue name.

VACCINATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023/24

It has been decided that the National Government will provide two special vaccinations (no self-pay) for elderly people and those at high risk of severe disease, and one dose for those aged 5 years and older who can be vaccinated. %Infants (6 months to 4 years old will continue to be vaccinated with conventional vaccines. Until now, it was basically unnecessary to wear a mask outdoors and necessary to wear it indoors but from March 13, the use of mask is based on personal judgment. However, please take into consideration the following situations.

To prevent the spread of infection to people around you, let's wear a mask...

♦ ... when you receive a medical examination or visit a medical institution or facility for the elderly.

... when riding a crowded train or bus during rush hours, etc.

To protect oneself from infection, wearing a mask is effective for senior citizens, those with underlying illnesses and pregnant women. It is also effective when a person at high risk of becoming seriously ill goes to a crowded place.

Please be careful not to force a person to put on or take off the mask against their will, and to respect the individual's judgement. Business operators as well as employees may be required to wear masks.

Accepting applications for Senior High School scholarships





Kyōiku Sōmu-ka (General Educational Affairs Section) 🖀 484-6182



The city grants scholarships that do not require repayment to those who are enrolled in High School and find it difficult to study due to financial reasons. In addition to 1st year High School students, 2nd and 3rd Year High School students can also apply.

Eligible people are those who fall under all of the following conditions:

- Living in Sakura City;
- 2. Graduated from Jr. High School, etc. and enrolled in High School, etc. within four years from the new fiscal
- 3. Have earned a grade point average of all the subjects (GPA) of 3.0 or higher on the 5 grade evaluation system during the third year of Junior High School and is motivated to learn.
- 4. Family income in the previous year was less than 1.3 times the maximum income eligibility level for public assistance, and deemed to have financial difficulties in attending Senior High School in this fiscal year.
- 5. Have a recommendation letter from the principal of the Junior High School from which the student graduated. Amount granted: Up to 80,000 Yen per year.

 (Please note that if the High School enrollment support fund by Chiba Prefecture is paid at the same time, the students are not eligible for grant or the amount equivalent to the payment could be reduced).

Application deadline: By May 2, 2023 (Tue). Applications received after the deadline will be accepted anytime until December 28 (Thur). In addition, those who move in from outside the city after April, we will accept applications until March 29, 2024 (Friday).

Applications: The application form can be downloaded from the City's website. Please attach documents and submit to Kyōiku Sōmu-ka in the City Hall. XAs for the documents to be attached, please see the website for details or contact us.



Vaccination of dogs against rabies

Inquiries: Seikatsu Kankyō-ka (Living Environment Section) 2484-6148

All dog owners must register their dog(s) and have them vaccinated against rabies once a year from April to the end of June and notify the city.

- ♣ The issuance of rabies vaccination certificates and dog tags have been entrusted to clinics:
- ◆ If your dog receives the vaccination during the handling period at any of the veterinary hospitals shown below, you can register and report to the city at the same time when the inoculation is done. (The procedure can also be carried out at the City Hall, Living Environment Section).
- ◆A red postcard is scheduled to be sent out in late March. Please carry it with you at the time of the inoculation.
- ◆ If you cannot confirm that your dog has been registered in Sakura City, you may not be able to register and notify the city at a veterinary clinic (list shown on the right).
- ◆ The mass rabies vaccinations for 2023 is scheduled in April. For details, please refer to the Rabies Vaccination Booklet or website. also contact the Living Environment Section.



SUBSIDIZED VACCINATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023

Pneumococcal vaccinations for senior residents.

① Senior citizens who will turn 65 years old in FY 2023 and have never been vaccinated: we will mail a preexamination form in early April.

2 People who have reached/will reach 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95 and 100 years-old in FY 2023 and have never been

vaccinated will receive guidance information by middle April.

③ As of the date of vaccination, those aged 60 to 64 years-old with a disability certificate 1st grade due to heart / renal / respiratory disorders or immune dysfunction please contact us.

Cost: 3,000 Yen – Self-pay if using the city's pre-examination form.

70 years-old routine vaccination finalizes in FY 2023; it won't be possible to obtain vaccination at public expense during the next 5 years, so please consider this opportunity if you wish to get vaccinated.

Second and subsequent vaccinations are optional (and all costs paid by the individual) so please consult with your family doctor.

Phase 2 measles-rubella (M R) vaccinations for preschoolers.

You can have your child vaccinated before he/she enters elementary school. Nursery school and kindergarten children born between April 2, 2017 and April 1, 2018 are eligible. Deadline: Until March 31, 2024.

Japanese encephalitis (JE) vaccinations.

Eligible people are those born between April 2, 2003 ~ April 1, 2007 who have reached and not older than 20 yearsold. Please contact us if you have not received 4 doses.

Human papilloma virus infection (Cervical cancer).

From April, a 9-valent vaccine (Gardasil 9) was added to routine vaccinations. Target groups are: ♦ Women born between April 2, 1997 ~ April 1, 2007 (catch-up vaccination) and ♦ Women born between April 2, 2007 ~ April 1, 2012 (routine vaccination)

Additional measures against Rubella

Eligible people are males born between April 2, 1962 and April 1, 1979. Deadline: Until March 2025. Coupons were sent in January 2023. Rubella antibody tests and vaccinations are available free of charge.
