# INTRODUCING SUPPORT FOR DEMENTIA AND VARIOUS LIFESTYLE SUPPORTS FOR THE ELDERLY.

As the population ages nationwide, one in three people in the city are over the age of 65 and the number of single-person households is increasing. The city is promoting various support measures with the aim of creating a town where people can continue to lead healthy lives as they age and maintain connections with the local community.

#### LIVING SUPPORT FOR THE ELDERLY.

The city, private organizations and local volunteers provide a variety of lifestyle support services.

#### MUTUAL SUPPORT SERVICE

A paid "mutual support service" provided by local volunteers is being implemented at 12 local social cooperatives for people who find it difficult to do everyday housework such as taking out the garbage, helping with shopping, weeding, changing light bulbs, etc.

#### SHOPPING SUPPORT SERVICE

For people who have trouble making daily purchases due to lack of means of transportation, various business operate mobile sales in the city such as Welcia, Yac's and Tokushimaru.

#### MOBILITY SUPPORT SERVICE


Paid transportation support services are provided for people in need of care or support who find it difficult to use public transportation alone. To use this service, you must register as a member in advance.

#### SPECIAL BENEFITS AS A SUPPORT MEASURE AGAINST SOARING PRICES

- ① Households exempt from residence tax in 2024 and households subject to only the per capita rate of residence tax in 2024. Benefits will be provided to households that will be newly exempt from the residence tax. The benefit amount is 100,000 Yen per household.
- Additional allowance for children in 2024. The amount is 50,000 per eligible child.
   Adjusted benefits for FY 2024. For those who are expected to have an amount that cannot be fully deducted from the fixed amount tax reduction for the 2024 income tax and the 2024 residence income tax, the shortfall will be paid as a benefit.

①&③Common details: A "Payment requirements confirmation Form" will be sent to the head of the household that is considered eligible for the payment(s), scheduled to be sent after July. Fill out the necessary information, attach the required documents and return it. The payment will take approximately 1 month to 1 and a half months after receipt. ### MEASURES AGAINST THE HEAT AND PREPARATIONS TO PROTECT YOURSELF

• Would you like to make a green curtain? Placing plants like a curtain outside a building or window block direct sunlight and lowers the indoor temperature. We recommend morning glories and bitter gourds, which are resistant to heat.

• Take shelter from the heat and cool off. As a measure to prevent heatstroke, we have set up "Sakura Cooling Rooms" in the city where you can avoid the heat and stay cool. Some cooling areas also have free water dispensers for your own bottles.

### **STRAY CATS - SPAYING AND NEUTERING**

In order to promote community cat activities, the city will subsidize part of the cost of spaying and neutering for stray cats.



All of the following requirements must be met: ①Request by a group of three or more people living in the city (excluding members of the same household).

②Consent must be obtained from the landowner of the area where the animals will be fed. ③Consent must be obtained from the local community association in the area where the activities will be carried out.

Subsidy amount: 10,000 Yen per animal for the cost of spaying and neutering.

Application period: July 1 (Mon) ~ 2025 Jan. 31 (Fri). The subsidy ends as soon as the budget runs out.

#### PLEASE BE CAREFUL OF CITY TAX & **REFUND FRAUDS!**



Refund scams are occurring nationwide, where scammers pretend to be city employees, offer to get your taxes refunded and lure people to ATM's to transfer cash.

#### The city will not ask you to use an ATM to receive your refund, nor will we provide you with refund information over the phone or email.

The actual flow of the city tax refund is as follows:

- ① The city sends a notification that a refund has occurred (named "Notice of Refund of overdue payments, etc.") in a sealed envelope.
- The "Remittance account form" enclosed in the  $(\mathcal{D})$ sealed envelope. Please fill out the form (named "Request form for refund of overdue payments, etc.") and send it in the return envelope.
- ③ After confirmation, the transfer will be made in about 2 to 3 weeks.

Municipal, Prefectural and Forest Environment Taxes for Fiscal Year 2024

- Notifications for salary deductions have already been sent to your workplace on May 17 (Fri).
- If you are eligible for a fixed amount tax reduction, the amount of the fixed amount tax reduction is indicated on your tax payment notice.
- For those who submitted tax returns after March 16, 2024, the contents may not be reflected in the notification. In that case, a tax amount change notice will be mailed to you at a later date.

### Pay your taxes through a convenient and safe bank transfer.

If you pay your taxes by bank transfer, you will save yourself the trouble of going to the counter every time your payment is due. The money is automatically deducted, so you don't have to worry about forgetting to pay it.

◆How to apply. Please fill in the necessary information on the bank transfer request form, affix your seal and complete the procedure at the counter.

•Application counters. Financial institutions with savings accounts (\*), Japan Post Bank, Sakura City Hall (Credit Management Division) or branch offices/dispatch centers. \*(Mizuho Bank, Mitsubishi UFJ Bank, Mitsui Sumitomo Bank, Resona Bank, Saitama Resona Bank, Chiba Bank, Chiba Kogyo Bank, Keiyo Bank, Chiba Shinkin Bank, Choshi Shinkin Bank, Sawara Shinkin Bank, Tokyo Higashi Shinkin Bank, Chiba Mirai Agricultural Cooperative). ◆Items required for application. Passbook, passbook registration seal, tax payment notice (or something that shows the notice number), request form for account transfer.

Please apply at least 2 months prior to the start of the account transfer.

✤The request forms for account transfer are available at the Credit Management Section, branch offices/dispatch centers and financial institutions in the city.
