Advances in digital technology are making our lives more convenient and enriching in many ways. In order to improve convenience for our residents, the city is promoting digitalization so that procedures and information can be smoothly obtained. We take this opportunity to introduce procedures that can be done without the need of going to the City Hall.

No waiting, convenient and cheaper than at the counter! You can obtain certificates such as copies of your resident's certificate at multi-copy machines installed in convenience stores, etc. All you have to do is follow the instructions on the screen and operate the machine so there is no need to fill out an application form like you would at a city hall counter. * To obtain a certificate at a convenience store, you will need your My Number card with the electronic user certificate attached. If you do not have a My Number card,

please consider obtaining it.

ADVANTAGES:

ANYTIME – The service is available every day from 6:30 AM to 11:00 PM. It can be used whenever necessary even when the City Hall counter is closed (at night or on holidays) ※Excluding the New Year holidays and maintenance times.

ANYWHERE – You can get the certificate from a multi-copy machine at your nearest convenience store anywhere in the country.

CHEAP – You can get the certificate for 50 yen cheaper than if you get it at the City Hall.

* Excluding the certificate of all family register details and the certificate of personal details.

PROCEDURES THAT CAN BE DONE ONLINE WITHOUT GOING TO THE CITY HALL You can carry out administrative procedures online using your computer or smartphone:

■ Chiba Electronic Application Service / My Number Portal. You can apply for the issuance of a city health checkup voucher set, register to participate in courses and events and complete procedures for childcare and nursing care.

CHECK ONLINE THE COUNTER CONGESTION STATUS AT ANY TIME

You can check how many people are waiting at the counter. Procedures such as moving, filing family register notifications and applying for national health insurance take time, so people often have to wait at the counter. For this reason, from September 1st, the Citizen's Affairs Section and Health and Medical Care section have made it possible to check the number of people waiting from home. This allows you to go when it is less congested and check your turn from a distance. Depending on the procedure, the waiting time may be longer or the turn may be delayed. Scan the QRC with your smartphone and select the counter you wish to check.

The QRC is also posted at the City Hall, Citizen's Affairs Section.

In order to reduce congestion at the application venue, please make a reservation for your application date and time using one of the methods below; then, come to the City Hall at the date and time notified to you by the city. %If you use the online application for the "Pittari Service", you don't need to make a reservation or visit the city office. • Reservations (Online reservations are given priority):

◆Online reservations: October 1 (Tue) from 10:00 ~ to November 30 (Sat). Please make the reservation using the Chiba electronic application service ->

◆Counter reservations: December 2 (Mon) to December 9 (Mon)

Admission applications. Application acceptance period: Monday through Friday from November 18 (Mon) to December 9 (Mon) 9:00 to 17:00.

**Only on the weekend of November 30 (Sat) and December 1 (Sun) applications will be accepted.



Reservations under any other method or after the application acceptance period will not be accepted.

• If you wish to have a nursery school outside the city, please contact the section in charge of the desired municipality as well as the Sakura City Hall, Childcare Section in advance. (Application forms and deadlines vary depending on the municipality)

If you wish to enroll in April 2025, applications will be accepted twice in April. However, only those kindergartens that do not reach capacity in the 1st screening will be eligible for the 2nd screening.
 Sakura Nursery school, Shizu Nursery schools and Sennari kindergarten accept children who require medical

Accepting applications for Senior High School scholarships

Kyōiku Sōmu-ka (General Educational Affairs Section) 🖀 484-6182

The city grants scholarships that do not require repayment to those who are enrolled in High School and find it difficult to complete their studies due to financial reasons. Eligible people are those who fall under all of the following conditions:

4 fiscal years. Have earned a grade point average of all the subjects of 3.0 or higher on the 5 grade evaluation was less than 1.3 times the maximum income eligibility level for public assistance and deemed to have financial difficulties in attending Senior High School in this fiscal year. Shave a recommendation letter from the principal of the Junior High School from which the student graduated.

Application deadline: Until December 27 (Fri). **Amount granted:** Up to 80,000 Yen per year. Applications: The application form can be downloaded from the City's website. Please attach documents and submit to Kyōiku Sōmu-ka in the City Hall. XAs for the documents to be attached. please see the website for details or contact us.



LET'S GET A COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING

Early detection of cancer is important! The only test required is a stool test taken over two days. Please get a cancer screening once a year to check your health.

In 2022, colorectal cancer was detected in the screenings of 22 people in Sakura City. In Japan,

1 in two people are diagnosed with cancer, one in 4 males and 1 in 6 females have died. Colorectal cancer is the number one cause of death in women and the second in men. Cancer has no subjective symptoms in the early stages but with prompt detection and treatment, more than 95% of patients are cured. Therefore, it is important to have regular screenings even if you do not have such subjective symptoms.

- ◆Target people: Those 40 years old or above as of March 31, 2025.
- ◆Individual examination: Until December 10, 2024 at cooperating medical institutions. Reservation required. Fee: 1,000 Yen.
- **◆Collective checkup:** Until March 6, 2025 at an assigned examination location. Fee: 400 Yen. For checkup dates, venues, etc. please check the information attached to the stool collection container, the screening information enclosed with your medical examination ticket set or visit the website →

In the case of individual examination, please pick up the container at the medical institution of your choice.

※If you do not have a 2024 medical examination ticket set, please apply for one.

ROUTINE VACCINATIONS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS INFLUENZA AND CORONAVIRUS BEGIN ON OCTOBER 1 ST





INFLUENZA CORONAVIRUS

Common matters:

Target people: as of the date of vaccination, those who are registered as residents of Sakura City and wish to be vaccinated. Those who are 65 years of age or older as of October 1, 2024, we will send out pre-examination forms so that they arrive by September 30.

People 65 years or older (born on or before January 1, 1960).

●People 65 years or older (born on or before April 1, 1960).

Common matters:

260~64 years old, with a disability certificate (Level 1) due to heart, kidney or respiratory problems. If you fall under category **2** and wish to be vaccinated, please contact us.

The low-cost program of influenza vaccinations for senior citizens starts on *October 1 and will be available through January 31, 2025.*

Coronavirus vaccinations start on October 1 and will be available through March 31, 2025.

Cost: 1,500 Yen

Cost: 3,500 Yen

Common matters:

♦ Vaccinations are optional to those who are not covered by the above, but the full cost will be borne by the individual. ♦ Eligible people can be inoculated at any cooperative medical institution in Sakura City as well as in Chiba Pref. ♦ Free for citizens on welfare. Please obtain a Welfare Recipient Certificate in advance and bring it to the medical institution on the vaccination day.

NOTICE OF COLLECTIVE SCREENINGS FOR BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCERS

Reservations for collective breast & cervical cancer screenings are being accepted from October 1 (Tue) From 9:00 ~ Breast cancer is more common in women in their 30's and cervical cancer in women in their 20's. Get screened for early detection.

Eligible targets are:

- **♦** Breast cancer screening: Women 30 years and older who did not undergo collective examination as well as mammography screening in the previous fiscal year. The examination will be conducted as follows:
- ◆ Cervical cancer screening: Women 20 years and older who did not take this screening in the previous fiscal year.

Online reservation, fax, mail or at the counter of each health center. For information on testing methods and schedules, please check the city's website → or the "Sakura City Examination Guide" enclosed in your Health checkup slip. ※A consultation ticket is required for the examination. If you have not received the consultation ticket, please contact the Health Management Center.
