Commemorating the restoration of the Koide Yoshio Athletics Stadium. The full marathon division is the only Japan Association of Athletics Federation's certified event in the prefecture!

- ▶ Marathon's date & place: March 30, 2025 (Sunday) Rain or shine. The course starts at Iwana Undō Kōen/Koide Yoshio Kinen Rikujō Kyōgijō (Iwana Sports Park / Koide Yoshio Commemorative Athletics Stadium).
- ▶ Registration period: November 15 (Friday) ~ December 28 (Saturday)
- ▶Eligibility: Those who can comply with the tournament rules and able to complete the applicable race within the time limit. Anyone who is able to participate and in good health
 - * Residents who live, work or study in the city. * Those under the age of 18 require parental consent.

LET'S PREVENT ACCIDENTS AND PREPARE FOR THEM!

PEACE OF MIND COMES FROM EACH INDIVIDUAL'S EFFORTS

As of the end of August 2024, there had been 196 traffic accidents in Sakura City resulting in injury, the 11th highest number among the 54 cities and towns in the prefecture. Traffic accidents cannot always be prevented by just being careful, but by thinking from the other person's perspective, you can reduce the risk of getting involved and minimize the damage. Let's learn about the current situation regarding traffic accidents in the city and think about what you can do.


USING A SMARTPHONE WHILE DRIVING IS A VIOLATION OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT.

Traffic accidents tend to increase from autumn to winter when the sun sets earlier and there are particularly many accidents around the New Year when people are more active; last year, about 30% of the accidents that occurred in the city happened between October and December.

Among the causes of accidents, the most common was: "failure to check for safety" (129 cases) followed by "failure to pay attention to the road ahead" (54 cases) and "failure to keep an eye on movements" (46 cases). These three causes alone accounted for more than 70% of traffic accidents in the city in 2023. In addition, despite the penalties being tightened since 2019, many accidents are occurring in the city due to people using smartphones while driving, a practice known as "distracted driving".

Don't think that "It's okay if I only use it for a little while". If you absolutely must use the smartphone, be sure to stop the car in a safe place first.

When an accident is caused by operating a smartphone or other device while driving a car, motorbike, etc. the following applies: Penalty: Imprisonment for up to one year or a fine of up to 300,000 Yen



In 2023, Sakura City ranked 11th in the Prefecture with 297 traffic accidents.



CITY SAFETY INITIATIVES

☐ Maintenance of road markings. Road markings are symbols that alert people to danger. There are two types: those installed by the Public Safety Commission (Police) and those installed by road administrators (National, prefectural, city, etc.) Both provide information to help prevent accidents, so please follow them.



↑The diamond symbol indicates pedestrian or bicycle crossing ahead.

☐ Installation of road reflectors (convex mirrors). In fiscal year 2023, 15 new convex mirrors were installed across the city. These mirrors are installed at intersections with poor visibility to help

you check for safety, but please do not rely on them as there are blind spots due to their structure. Whether there is a convex mirror or not, you should always slow down and check for safety at intersections. If you discover a broken or damaged convex mirror, please confirm the location (or a landmark if you don't know the address) and contact the city.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE FOR THE ELDERLY **NEW INSURANCE CARDS WILL NO LONGER BE** ISSUED

After December 2, it will no longer be possible to change the information on your health insurance card or issue a new one, including for lost health insurance cards. Current health insurance cards can be used until their expiration date.

MEDICAL CARE FOR THE ELDERLY

For the time being, to those who joined after December 2, a Certificate of Eligibility "shikaku kakuninsho" will be issued regardless your status. New certificates of limit application will no longer be issued. The classification will be stated on the Certificate of Eligibility "shikaku kakuninsho"

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE

• People who have a My Number Card (Myna Health Insurance Card) that has been registered for use as a health insurance card:

➤ You will be issued a Notice of Eligibility Information "shikaku joho tsuchisho" that can confirm your insured status. Please present your Myna Health Insurance Card at the medical institution. If your Myna Health Insurance Card cannot be used, please present both the Notice of Eligibility Information and your Myna Health Insurance Card.

•If you do not have a Myna Health Insurance Card: For the time being, we will issue you a Certificate of Eligibility "shikaku kakuninsho" which can be used in the same way as your health insurance card.

 Those who are planning to enroll in National Health Insurance for the first time:

>Due to the transition of the system, if you subscribe between November 18 (Mon) and December 1 (Sun), or for a future date after December 2, we will mail you a

"Certificate of Eligibility" or a "Notice of Eligibility Information" at a later date. *There will be no changes to the National Health Insurance Limit Applicable Certificate, etc.

BONE MARROW TRANSPLANT - DONOR SUPPORT PROJECT IN SAKURA CITY

The city provides subsidies to donors and businesses where donors work, with the aim of increasing the number of bone marrow and peripheral blood stem cell donors as well as promoting transplants.



Subsidy targets:

- ●Those who live in the city and have donated bone marrow, etc. through the bone marrow bank program run by the Japan Marrow Donation Foundation.
- Those who live in the city and whose bone marrow donation was cancelled after giving final consent
- ●The donor's workplace has granted the donor a "donor leave" (special leave taken for hospitalization to undergo tests required for bone marrow donation, etc.) ※Those who gave final consent to donate bone marrow, etc. but whose donation was cancelled, they are now newly covered from Fiscal Year 2024.

Subsidy amount:

The amount will be paid according to the number of days of hospital visits, etc. and the number of days of donor leave given.

- →Donor: 20,000 Yen per day. (Maximum of 140,000 Yen per donation of bone marrow, etc.)
- →Businesses: 10,000 Yen per day (Up to 70,000 Yen per donor).

To apply, you will need to submit a certificate issued by the Japan Marrow Donor Bank. Please contact us for details on the required documents. If you would like to register as a donor, please contact the Japan Marrow Bank directly.




