

Adult Guardianship System

This is a system for appointing an "adult guardian" por people who lack sufficient judgement capacity due to dementia, intellectual disabilities, mental disorders, etc., and for protecting their legal rights in contracts, etc.

Municipal, Prefectural and Forest Environment Taxes for Fiscal Year 2025

Municipal, Prefectural and Forest Environment taxes are calculated based on income from January to December, 2024 and are levied at the address as of January 1, 2025. In addition, the fixed tax reduction will not be applied to fiscal year 2025 except for some eligible individuals. Therefore, even if the income amount and income deduction amount are not significantly different from fiscal year 2024, the tax amount will be higher in fiscal year 2025.

PLEASE BE CAREFUL OF CITY TAX REFUND FRAUDS!



There have been a number of "refund frauds" across the country in which

scammers pose as city officials, offer tax refunds and lure victims to ATM's to have them transfer cash.

The city will not ask you to use an ATM to receive your refund, nor will we contact you by phone or email regarding your refund.

The actual flow of the city tax refund is as follows: The city sends a notification that a refund has been issued (named "Notice of Refund of overdue payments, etc.")

Please fill out the form (named "Request form for refund of overdue payments, etc.") enclosed with the letter and send it in the return envelope.
After confirmation, the transfer will be made in about 2 to 3 weeks.

In that case, we will send you a notice of tax amount change at a later date. In addition, the delay in taxation may affect other systems (such as insurance premiums calculated using tax information).

Changes for FY 2025

◆Fixed tax reduction for spouses living in the same household (excluding spouses eligible for exemption). Those who have a total income of more than 10 million yen and up to 18'050,000 million yen or below in 2024 (20 million yen or less in the case of salary income only) and who have a spouse living in the same

household (excluding spouses eligible for exemption) can receive a tax reduction of 10,000 yen. For details, please see the website →



SCHOOL LUNCH SUBSIDY FOR THE **3**RD AND SUBSEQUENT CHILDREN

In order to reduce the financial burden of raising children on large families, subsidies will be provided to cover the cost of school lunches for the third and subsequent children during the compulsory education period. **Deadline:** July 16 (Wed). **Target:** Guardians who meet all the following conditions from **1** to **3 O** Supporting three or more children.

The household does not receive full subsidies for school lunch through the national, prefectural or city governments.

There are no tardy or unpaid school lunch fees in the household.

THE FOOD HYGIENE SUMMER COUNTERMEASURE PERIOD **IN CHIBA PREFECTURE IS JUNE ~ SEPTEMBER**

The hot and humid summer is the time when food poisoning caused by bacteria such as campylobacter and enterohemorrhagic Escherichia coli O157 is most likely to occur. Food poisoning can occur not only in restaurants but also in homes, so be careful when handling food to prevent it.

TIPS FOR PREVENTING FOOD POISONING AT HOME:

At the time of purchase:

► Check the expiration date, etc. ► Buy fresh and frozen foods last. ► Wrap meat, fish, etc. in separate plastic bags to prevent juices from getting on other foods. ►Go back home right away without making any detours.

When saving:

► Store refrigerated or frozen foods in the refrigerator or freezer immediately after bringing them home. Keep the refrigerator below 10° C and the freezer below -15° C. ►Don't overfill the fridge or freezer.

When cooking:

► Wash your hands thoroughly with soap before cooking. ► Use separate knives and cutting boards for meat, fish and vegetables or rinse and put boiling water over them before using. ► Cook meat and fish thoroughly. The recommended cooking time is 75° C for at least 1 minute until the center temperature reaches 75° C. ► Defrost only the amount of frozen foods you will use and do not repeatedly freeze and defrost it.

At meal times:

► Wash your hands with soap before eating. ►Don't leave cooked food at room temperature for a long time.

Leftover food:

► After washing your hands, divide into small portions and store in clean utensils and containers so that they cool down quickly. Throw away anything that is ► When reheating, heat too old. thoroughly. The recommended heating time is 75° C for at least one minute.

► On the dates of the pesticide spraying, please refrain from entering or driving into the sprayed areas. ► We use highly safe chemicals. However, households living near the spraying areas should refrain from storing food or drinks outside.

▶ Do not enter the rice fields where the product has been sprayed for about 5 days.
